This report summarizes the work of the Kapi'olani Community College Foundations Board during the 2007-2008 school year.

Course renewals

No course renewals were submitted as all proposal and renewal documents for Foundation courses are current.

New Foundation courses

The Math Department requested that the Foundations Board designate MATH 112, Mathematics for Elementary Teachers II, as Foundations, Symbolic Reasoning course. The proposal is currently under revision.

Communication is on going with the Math Department about Foundations Designation Proposals for MATH 103, Fundamentals of College Algebra, and MATH 135, Elementary Functions. Since Math 103 and 135 serve or will serve as Foundations courses at Honolulu, Leeward, and Windward Community Colleges, Kapi'olani Community College should augment its course designation to gain uniformity within the Community College System on Oahu.

Multi-campus Foundations Board

In Fall 2007 the Multi-campus Foundations Board, composed of chairs of UH Manoa, Honolulu Community College, Kapiolani Community College, Leeward Community College, and Windward Community College initiated discussions to consider the request from Maui Community College to join the multi-campus Foundations agreement. The discussions were valuable for the incoming new chairs in clarifying courses that fulfill Foundations requirements that are system-wide and additional graduation requirements which varies for each campus. The request was approved in January 2008.
