Foundations Board Annual Report

This report summarizes the work of the Kapi'olani Community College (KCC) Foundations Board during the 2008-2009 academic year.

Course Renewals

No renewals were received for this academic year. Although the Math 111 and Math 203 Foundations designation will expire at the end of Summer 2009, no renewal proposals were received after the previous Foundations Board Chair had contacted both the Instructor of Math 111 and the Mathematics Coordinator for Math 203 to submit a renewal proposal.

New Foundations Course

No renewals were received for this academic year. The Foundations Board is awaiting the Math 112 (Mathematics for Elementary Teachers II), proposal required revisions to determine if Foundation Hallmarks have been met.

The Foundations Board is also waiting for Foundation Course Designation proposals for Math 103 (Fundamentals of College Algebra), Math 115 (Statistics), and Math 135 (Elementary Functions). The Board voted last year to augment its course designations to gain uniformity within the Community College System on Oahu to provide KCC students with more opportunities to articulate Gen Ed credits to UH Manoa and the other community colleges that are participants in the multi-campus board and to be in agreement with Honolulu, Leeward, and Windward Community Colleges.

Multi-campus Foundations Board

The multi-campus Foundations Board, composed of the Foundation Board chairs of UH Manoa (UHM), Kapi'olani Community College (KCC), Leeward Community College (LCC), Honolulu Community College (HCC), Windward Community College (WCC), Maui Community College (MCC), and Kauai Community College (KauCC), will meet on April 27, 2009.
