Native, common, esp. at E end of island



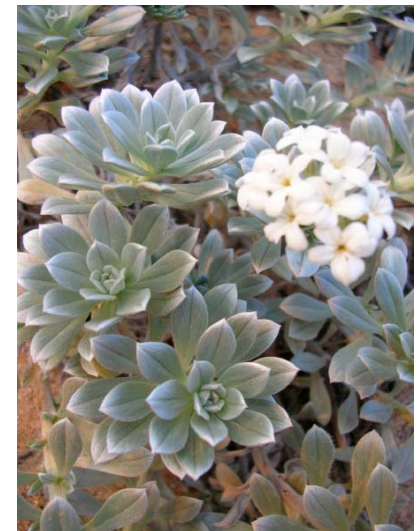
Aweoweo
