HB 1339 HD1 SD1 – RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

Chair Tokuda, Vice Chair Dela Cruz and members of the committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of HB 1339 HD1 SD1 which restructures the Hawai'i Invasive Species Council as the Hawai'i Invasive Species Authority to coordinate implementation of the Hawaii Interagency Biosecurity plan and related duties, and appropriates funds for this purpose.
