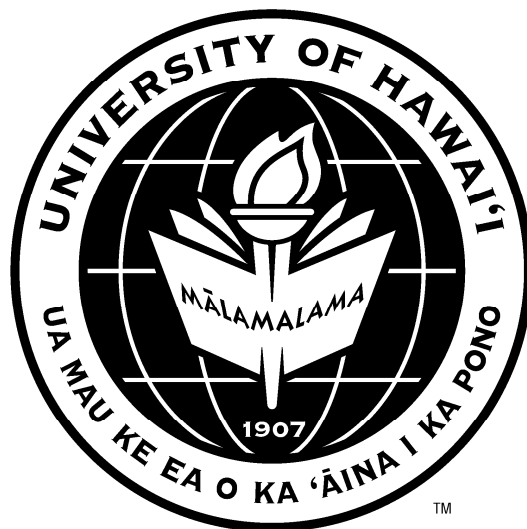


# UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI‘I SYSTEM REPORT



REPORT TO THE 2018 LEGISLATURE

Report on Contracts Awarded to Women-, Veteran-, and  
Native Hawaiian-owned Businesses

Senate Concurrent Resolution 59 SD1 (2017)

September 2017

The Hawai'i State Legislature adopted SCR 59 SD1 (2017), which requested the Department of Transportation, Department of Accounting and General Services, Department of Education, and the University of Hawai'i submit to the Legislature, no later than October 1, 2017, a list of state contracts under the department or agency awarded to women-, veteran-, and Native Hawaiian-owned businesses in the last two years.

This report includes the University of Hawaii's response to the above-mentioned concurrent resolution in respect to women-owned and Native Hawaiian-owned businesses during the period of July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016.

There was only one contract award to a woman-owned business through the professional services method of procurement with the University of Hawai'i.

There were two contract awards to Native Hawaiian-owned businesses under the competitive sealed bidding method of procurement with the University of Hawai'i.

Unfortunately, at present, no state agency, including the University of Hawai'i, maintains lists such as those requested by this concurrent resolution. The closest list available is the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) List that the Department of Transportation (DOT) maintains. DOT's list has been broken down by DBE women and DBE Native Hawaiian-owned firms, but DOT does not maintain such a list for veteran-owned businesses.

This report was produced by obtaining a copy of the State Procurement Office's procurement awards from 7/1/15 – 6/30/16 and cross-referenced the names against the Department of Transportation's DBE Directory of Women and Hawaiian Owned Firms.
