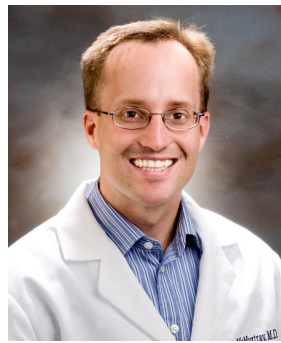

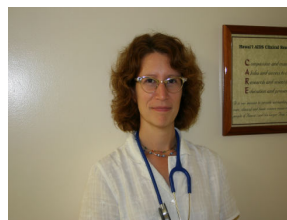
The Clinic's mission
