

**HISTORY MAJOR REQUIREMENTS**  
(Effective Fall Semester 2003)

Eleven courses (33 credit hours) in history with a grade of C or better, distributed according to History Department requirements:

- Minimum of five courses in one of the following four fields: United States, Asia/Pacific, Europe, Comparative/World.
- Minimum of one upper-division course in each of the three other fields.
- HIST 396 and HIST 496.
- One additional history course.

No more than two 200-level courses may be used toward the History major. 100-level courses do not count toward completing the major.
