

Confidentiality and Ethics Role Plays

- You have been assigned a case. You have a long term lover. How much can you tell him about your PWA?

1. Is it okay for them to meet?

- You are assigned as a Peer and you see your PWA at a bar. What do you do?

1. He sees you but does not acknowledge your presence.
2. He sees you and comes to greet you.
3. He comes to greet you and you are with friends, how should you introduce him?
4. He offers to buy you a drink.
5. He wants to talk to you about his problems, now.
6. He is drunk and won't leave you alone.
7. You are drunk and trying to cruise this thing next to you.

- You have been assigned as a Peer. After two months into the relationship you find yourself having recurrent sexual fantasies about his lover. How do you handle these?

1. The lover mentions that he is interested in you also.
2. Your PWA dies and his lover asks you out on a date.

- You have been assigned as a Peer and you suspect that one of the other volunteers involved in the case is stealing from the PWA. What do you do?

1. You suspect that he is taking a few of the PWAs pills.
2. You suspect that the other volunteer is drinking before coming to assist.
3. You suspect that the other volunteer is having sex with the PWA.

- You have been assigned as a Peer and after three months into the relationship, you find yourself attracted to one of the other volunteers working on the case.

1. Is it okay to date?

- Your PWA tells you that he is thinking about committing suicide. What do you do?

1. He is drunk when he tells you this.
2. He tells you that he has saved up medication.
3. He asks you, makes you promise not to tell anyone, especially Michael.
4. You come to visit and find him unconscious after an apparent suicide attempt and he has explicitly told you he does not want to die in the hospital, no matter what.

- You learn that one of the clients who has AIDS is dating your

- You learn that one of the clients who has AIDS is dating your friend and you know that your friend likes to get fucked and refuses to use a condom. What do you do?
 1. You hear from friends that your PWA is cruising the parks.
 2. You are at a party and learn that your PWA is sharing needles with the host in the bathroom.
- Your PWA wants to meet your family and suggests that he go with you to your family Thanksgiving. Your parents are avid supporters of Jim and Tammy Bakker.
- You are at a party and hear one of the other guests say what a horrible organization the Life Foundation is and you would like to say something. What can you say?
 1. You meet another member of your training class at a party and go up to meet him/her.
 2. You hear someone state that he is member of the Life Foundaiton and proceed to state that he is sexually involved with his PWA.
- You are assigned as a Peer and after two months into the relationship you realize that you cannot stand the PWA you have been assigned.
 1. He hasn't contacted you in three weeks and that is fine with you.
 2. You find yourself getting sick everytime that you are supposed to call him.
 3. You are afraid to tell Michael of the situation because you are sure that he will never assign you again if you fuck this one up.
- Your PWA complains about his doctor. You listen and suspect that he may not be receiving proper medical care.
 1. Your PWA tells you that he is no longer taking his AZT and instead is using flower petal therapy. He looks like he is getting worse. Can you inform his physician?
- You and your partner are at the store and run into a PWA that you know of from the Peer Support Group. He comes up to greet you and he is looking very ill.
 1. How do you introduce him?
 2. He talks of his medical problems and is very angry.
 3. He states that he does not expect to be around for more than a few more months and wishes that it was all over already.
