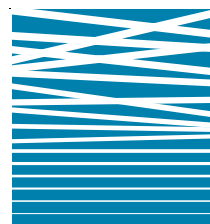

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# Goals of the Home Study Module

**The purpose of this module is to provide an update of basic STD knowledge in preparation for the on-site portion of the course which will include:**

**Observing and then performing the examination and management of patients presenting at the STD Clinic.**

**Discussing case studies in small groups.**

**Performing and interpreting stat laboratory tests (mainly wet mounts).**

The emphasis is on the ambulatory management of STDs. Each section is preceded by learning objectives which we feel are important to achieve in order to maximize the learning experience for the clinical portion of the course. It will insure that all students arrive at the sites with the same knowledge base, and will allow more time for clinical activities as opposed to didactic sessions. Some sections have accompanying videotapes as indicated by the icon.

**It is expected that all accepted students participate in all aspects of this three day STD Intensive Course which includes reviewing all the material (text and video) contained in this home study module.**
