This bibliography covers books, articles and chapters which appeared in 1999 and the early part of 2000, with some of earlier date sighted too late for inclusion previously. Most official publications are excluded. Works of fiction are usually omitted unless they are considered likely to be of special interest to Pacific historians. Books, articles, chapters and reprints are interfiled. To reduce annotations to a minimum, items are classified by geographical area, unless the theme covers more than one island group. In this case, they will be found under a subject heading. An attempt has been made to supply complete and accurate bibliographical details based on personal examination, but this is not always possible if a work has been published outside Australia. Items are numbered and an author index has been provided.

Many people have contributed to the bibliography. I particularly wish to thank Frédéric Angleviel, who has provided extensive listings for New Caledonia, Niel Gunson, Robert Langdon, Hugh Laracy and Jennifer Terrell.
