

## FTE Student to FTE Staff Ratios for UH Peer and Benchmark Institutions

This report includes tables showing FTE student to FTE staff ratios (SSRs). A few caveats:

- \$ The definition of FTE (full-time equivalent) used in the tables is based on the IPEDS definition, in use nationally, in which FTE is the full-time count plus 1/3 of the part-time count. This is different from the FTE we use internally in our MAPS reports.
- \$ All staff FTE calculations exclude graduate assistants and faculty in all categories (instruction, research and public service)
- \$ The data are early release data taken from the National Center for Education Statistics Peer Analysis System, and are subject to change.
- \$ There is a benchmark group for UH Manoa, UH Hilo and the UH community college system only. There is no benchmark group for UH West O'ahu and the individual UH community colleges. There are peer groups for all UH campuses.

### **Benchmark group: SSR comparisons:**

UH campuses rank in the bottom 5<sup>th</sup> of their benchmark groups in SSRs. In general they have much higher student/staff ratios than their benchmark institutions. UH Manoa is 4<sup>th</sup> from the bottom, that is, 84% of its benchmark institutions have lower SSRs. UH Hilo ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> from the bottom; 87% of its benchmark institutions have lower SSRs. The UHCCs overall rank 3<sup>rd</sup> from the bottom, but again individual campuses vary with Kaua'i CC ranking just below the top ranking institution, and Leeward and Kapi'olani at 2<sup>nd</sup> from the bottom.

UH institutions do not rank strongly among their peer institutions in SSRs. In general, they have higher SSRs than their peer institutions. Nine out of 10 UH campuses fall at or below the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in their respective peer groups, and over half the UH institutions are in the bottom 5<sup>th</sup> of their groups. Two campuses, UH West O'ahu and Hawai'i CC are at the bottom of their peer group rankings. Kaua'i CC ranks highest amongst its peer institutions, at the 76<sup>th</sup> percentile.

## Summary

Overall, UH institutions are less well staffed than either their peer or benchmark institutions and, with the exception of Kaua'i CC and to a lesser extent Maui CC, are at or very near the bottom in the rankings.
