

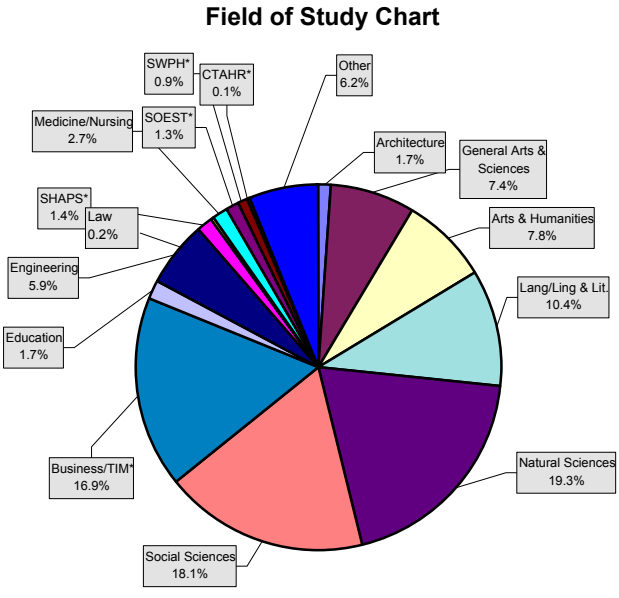
**Spring 2002 Fact Sheet**  
**International Student Services**  
**University of Hawai'i at Manoa**

The International Student Services (ISS) monitors the academic and visa status of foreign citizens who enroll at UHM under a non-immigrant student visa. In addition to the **1,465** currently registered students, **99** graduates now remain in the US for a limited period of practical training experience (employment), generally a 12-month period, under the visa sponsorship of the University. Compared to Spring 2001, enrollment has increased by **142** students (10.7%).

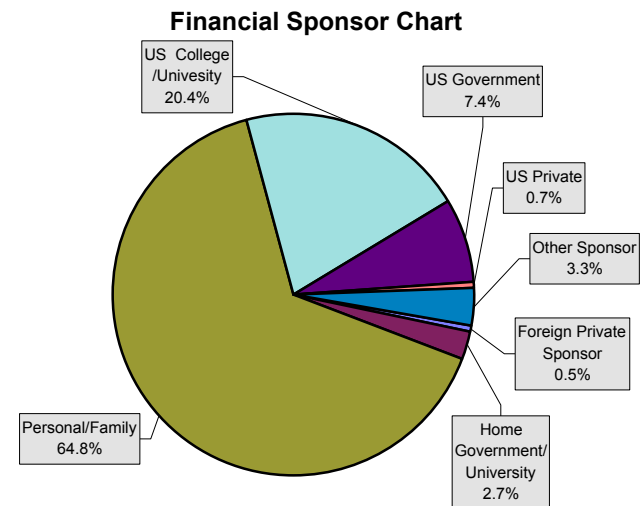
