

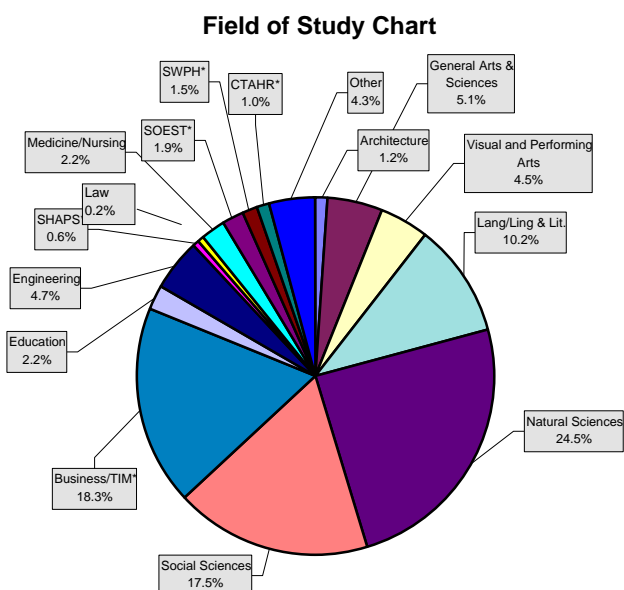
Spring 2004 Fact Sheet International Student Services University of Hawai'i at Manoa

The International Student Services (ISS) monitors the academic and visa status of foreign citizens who enroll at UHM under a non-immigrant student visa. In addition to the **1,562** currently registered students, 152 graduates now remain in the US for a limited period of practical training experience (employment), generally a 12-month period, under the visa sponsorship of the University.
