

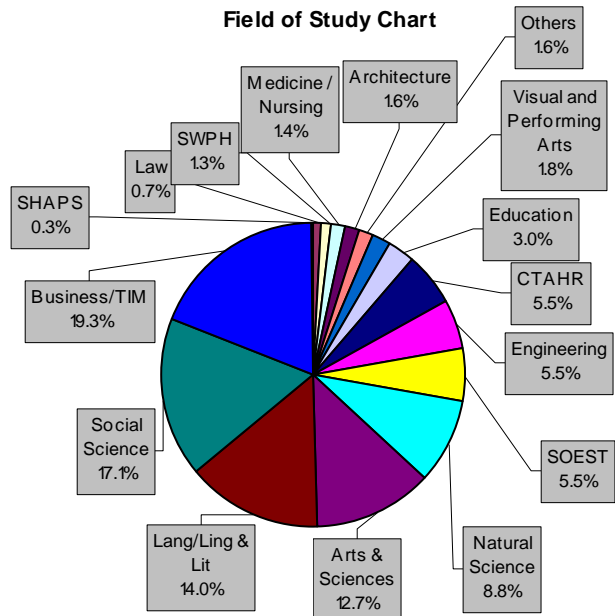
Spring 2005 Fact Sheet

The International Student Services (ISS) monitors the academic and visa status of foreign citizens who enroll at UHM under a non-immigrant student visa. In addition to the **1,519** currently registered students, **134** graduates now remain in the US for a limited period of practical training experience (employment), generally a 12-month period, under the visa sponsorship of the University.

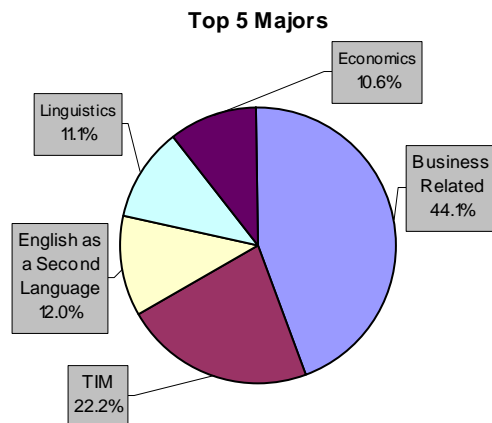
