

Spring 2008 Fact Sheet International Student Services University of Hawai'i at Mānoa

The International Student Services (ISS) monitors the academic and visa status of foreign citizens who enroll at UHM under a non-immigrant student visa, excluding Intensive English-only students. In addition to the **1620** currently registered students, **188** graduates remain for a limited period of practical training experience (employment), under the visa sponsorship of the University.

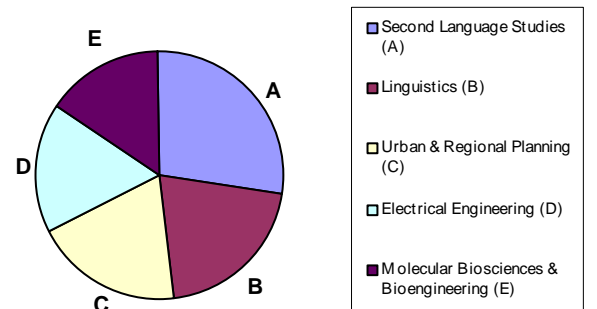

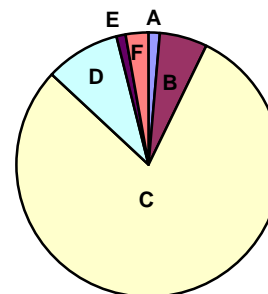

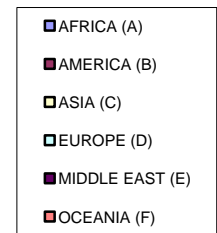
