A limited number of full and partial Graduate Teaching Assistantships are available for students accepted in the KRS MS Degree Program. These assistantships include stipend, and in state and out of state tuition waivers.

Responsibilities:

Graduate Assistantship responsibilities include: teaching KRS classes*, departmental work, clinical work, and research. Students are expected to work 20 hours per week, as directed by their supervisors.

**KRS classes include the following: Aerobic fitness, basketball first aid, judo, badminton, yoga, swimming (WSI), golf, social dance, dances of Hawaii, tennis, volleyball, weight training, karate, water polo, ta'i chi, tumbling and rebound tumbling, track and field, field invasion sports, fitness, etc.*

Requirements for Candidates for Assistantships

The candidate must submit the following:

1. Application and transcripts of academic work to the Graduate Division
2. MS Application and statement of academic goals and three letters of recommendation to the KRS Department
3. Graduate Assistantship Application to the KRS Department

Basis for Selection

Each candidate must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university prior to the opening of the school year for which the appointment is made. The candidate must have adequate preparation in the specific area in which she/he is applying. The candidate must meet the Graduate Division admission requirements and be accepted into the KRS MS Degree Program.

Applications are processed on a rolling basis with assistantship positions awarded on an annual basis each March for the subsequent Fall semester.
