Dear Dr. Gazan:

On behalf of the Committee on Accreditation (COA/the Committee) of the American Library Association (ALA), I write to inform you that the Committee voted to grant Continued Accreditation status to the program leading to the degree of Master of Library and Information Science at the University of Hawaii.

The next comprehensive review visit is scheduled for fall 2022 unless the COA is persuaded to take other action in the interim. The accreditation status of this program explicitly includes all sites offering courses that are part of the program listed above.

This decision was made at the Committee meeting on January 10, 2016. The decision was based on the Program Presentation, the External Review Panel Report, all of the reports the program submitted to the Committee since the last comprehensive review, and the January 9, 2016, meeting with you and Ann Curry, Chair of the External Review Panel.

The decision to grant Continued Accreditation to the program was based on the "totality of the accomplishment and the environment for learning...rather than from a consideration of the isolated particulars" (*Standards*, Introduction).

From this point forward, all reporting must address the revised *Standards for Accreditation* adopted by ALA Council on February 2, 2015. Electronic versions of the 2015 *Standards* are available at ala.org/accreditation. The spreadsheet that maps the 2008 *Standards* to the 2015 *Standards* may be especially helpful in the transition.
