PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST REGULATIONS

Age Divisions:

This contest is open to individual students and/or adults in the following four divisions

- Students currently enrolled in Second Grade – Fifth Grade
- Students currently enrolled in Sixth Grade – Eighth Grade
- Students currently enrolled in Ninth grade – Twelfth Grade
- Adults 18 and over

Photograph Size and Format:

Original, unpublished photographs must be taken by entrant and submitted as color or black & white prints on 8"x10" photo-quality paper. While cropping photos is permitted, compositional changes and tonal or color cast corrections to digital photos are not acceptable and will be disqualified. No photo in which a person is recognizable will be accepted. **Only one submission per entrant is permitted and photographs MUST highlight native plant species of Hawai'i to qualify for this contest. A list of online Hawaiian plant resources to aid you in your research can be found on our website.**

To enter our Endangered Species Day Photography Contest, you must include a completed *Entry Form* with the required information attached firmly to the back of the photograph. Entrants must also include a *Photograph Caption Form* with their submission. To protect photos, entries should be packaged with appropriate cardboard stiffeners or in plastic sleeves.

Deadline for submissions is Monday, May 3rd, 2010

Entries must be received, or postmarked by, Monday, May 3rd, 2010. *Photographs will be judged by Lyon Arboretum staff, volunteers, and visitors and announced by 4:00pm on Friday, May 14th, 2010.* Photographs will remain on display throughout the month of May. Mail entries to:
