

University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Registration Error Messages for UH Mānoa Students

During your online **MyUH registration** session, **error messages** will inform you of conditions that prevent you from enrolling in classes. The following are explanations of the error messages that may be displayed and the recommended courses of action.

To minimize receiving error messages, look for **restricted course** comments in the course listings of the **Schedule of Classes** or **Check Class Availability** site <http://myuh.hawaii.edu/uhdad/avail.classes?i=MAN> and find **course prerequisite** requirements in the course descriptions of the **UH Mānoa Catalog**. <http://www.catalog.hawaii.edu> Consult the **Check Class Availability** site during your registration session since it provides **updated course offering** information and **number of seats** remaining.

For **restricted courses** (see right hand column), the appropriate **approval override code** must be entered into your **student record** by the authorized departmental representative **before** you will be able to register for the course. You may **view these override codes** on your **Check My Registration Status** page. Please remember that **you must still register for the course** within your designated registration period. Instructors and departmental staff are not able to register students for classes.

Error Message Displayed while Registering	Explanation	Recommended Action	Restricted Courses: Approval Override Code Required
Cancelled	This course section has been cancelled for the semester.	Review the Schedule of Classes, Check Class Availability site, or the Search and Register for Classes page for a different section of the course.	
Cancelled - Prerequisite unmet on (date)	You have been disenrolled from the course because you no longer meet the prerequisites (e.g. you did not receive an acceptable grade for the prerequisite course).	If you feel that you are qualified to enroll in the course, check with the department offering the course immediately. If the department allows you to enroll in the course, you must obtain approval and re-register for the class (if seats are still available) within the registration period. Error Message Displayed while Registering	Explanation	Recommended Action	Restricted Courses: Approval Override Code Required
Registration Update Warning	The prerequisite for this course has not been met due to receiving a final grade lower than what's required.	Drop the course via MyUH. If you feel that you are qualified to enroll in the course, check with the department offering the course immediately, since they may disenroll you from the course. If the department allows you to remain in the course, they must enter the Mānoa Course Approval Override Code which will also eliminate the warning message.	
Student Status Prohibits Registration	You cannot register for Mānoa courses since you are not currently eligible to enroll.	If you have been admitted to Mānoa and received this message in error, please call the Registration Helpline at (808) 956-8010.	
Time Conflict with xxxxx	The course you are attempting to register for overlaps with a course in which you are already registered.	Review your course selections to avoid time conflicts. If you are requesting to take overlapping courses you must obtain both instructors' written permission and obtain approval from the Student Academic Services office of your college .	Mānoa Time Override Code
Time Ticket Restriction	You cannot register for Mānoa courses since it is not your assigned time to register.	Refer to the cover of the Schedule of Classes for registration dates by student classification. Refer to the MyUH Registration Timetable for Mānoa students to find your actual assigned registration time.
