Major Curriculum/Program Changes

- Liberal Arts Associate in Arts (AA) degree requirements:
 - Only MATH 100 or higher fulfills Quantitative Reasoning (PHIL 110 no longer accepted).
 - HIST 151 + Additional World Culture Area Course required.
 - Asia Pacific Culture Class + 1 Humanities Area Course required
 - 1 Biological Science + 1 Physical Science + 1 Lab required
 - 2 Social Science Courses required
 - General Electives increased from 11 credits to 23 credits.
- ABRP Certificate of Competency for Basic Auto Body deleted.
- ABRP Certificate of Competency for Auto Body Repair and Painting deleted.
- Architectural, Engineering & CAD (AEC) Technologies program modifications made
- AEC Certificate of Achievement – Geomatics & GIS approved.
- AEC Certificate of Competence – Geospatial Technologies approved.
- AEC Certificate of Competence – Sustainable Lot Design & Site Prep approved.
- ENG 106 (Technical English for the Workplace) course approved.

Initiatives supporting the 2+2 pathways
