MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

University of Hawai‘i Maui College Human Services Associate in Science (AS)
Early Childhood Specialization
to the
University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa Bachelor of Education in Elementary
and Early Childhood Education

The purpose of this Agreement is to facilitate the smooth transition of students completing the Associate in Science (AS) in Human Services – Early Childhood Specialization Program at University of Hawai‘i Maui College to the University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa College of Education Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) Program in Elementary and Early Childhood Education.

This agreement will relate only to those students who **complete** the University of Hawai‘i Maui College Associate in Science in Human Services – Early Childhood Specialization Program. Students in good standing in the Associate in Science Human Services – Early Childhood Specialization Program (2006 or later) at University of Hawai‘i Maui College are eligible to apply for admission to this University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa (UHM) program in anticipation of completing the AS with final acceptance into the program contingent upon such completion and meeting the designated criteria for admission to the College of Education (COE) at UHM.

The 40 hours of documented field experience required for entry into the COE program will be considered met by successful completion of the two University of Hawai‘i Maui College field experience courses required for the AS degree, currently **ED 190, 191V, or 291V**. Each field experience course practicum requires 120 to 225 hours working with pre-school aged children. Students are familiarized with the Hawai‘i Preschool Content Standards for 4-year-olds that are accepted by the Hawai‘i Board of Education.

Students intending to enter the COE with this AS must also fulfill the UHM General Education Foundation and Diversification Requirements. The following specific courses from University of Hawai‘i Maui College should be taken as part of the AS to meet the COE requirements: **MATH 111, MATH 112, HWST 107, FAMR 230, and MUS 253** or other Diversification Arts (DA) course.

The University of Hawai‘i Maui College Associate in Science Human Services – Early Childhood Specialization from Fall 2006 meets the body of knowledge for the Elementary Education Emphasis *performing arts course requirement*, and for the following four courses in the Early Childhood Education Specialization at UHM.


- FAMR 331 and FAMR 332
- ITE 417 and ITE 425


As part of this agreement, UHM-COE agrees that the Office of Student Academic Services (OSAS) will collaborate with University of Hawai‘i Maui College counselors and the Human Services Early Childhood Program Coordinator to ensure that accurate information is transmitted


to students. UHM-COE administration will help facilitate meetings with faculty and administrators as needed to discuss changes or revisions to this agreement. University of Hawai'i Maui College counselors will work to ensure that AS students are advised of UHM-COE's Core and Emphasis requirements and will collaborate with UHM-COE personnel as needed. University of Hawai'i Maui College Human Services Early Childhood Educational Coordinator will provide to OSAS each semester a letter indicating those students who have completed or will complete the AS in that semester.


This Agreement will remain in effect until Spring 2012 and will be subject to COE curricular changes, review and renewal during that semester. The Agreement may be revised or discontinued with the consent of both parties at any time.






