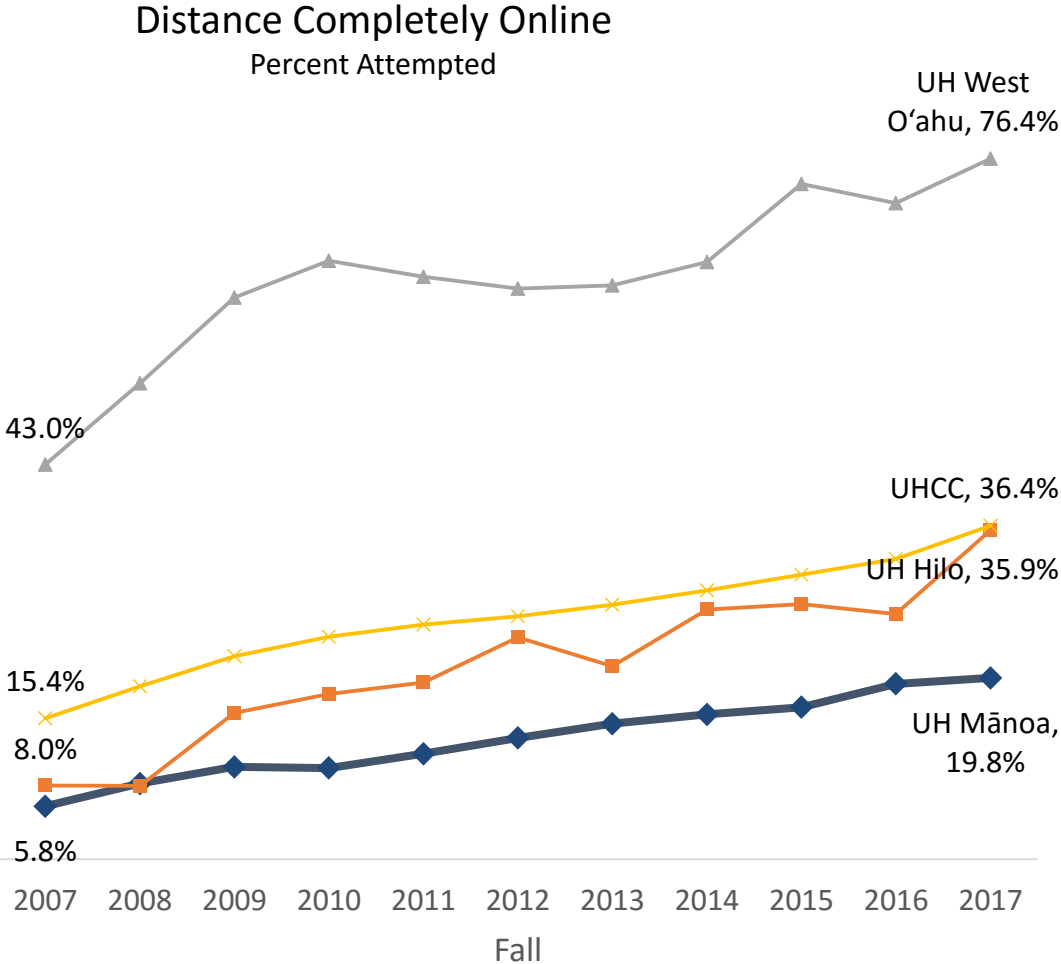

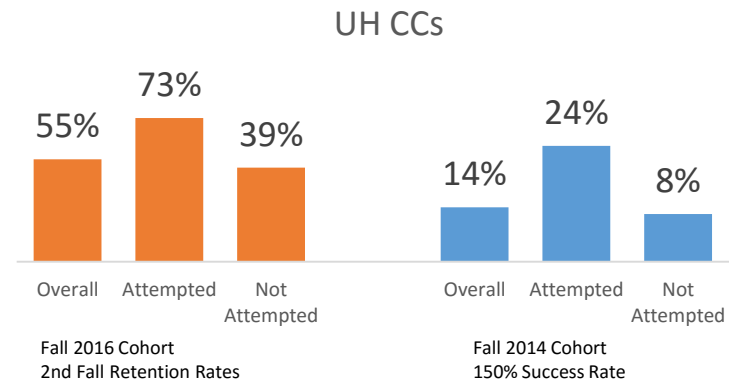
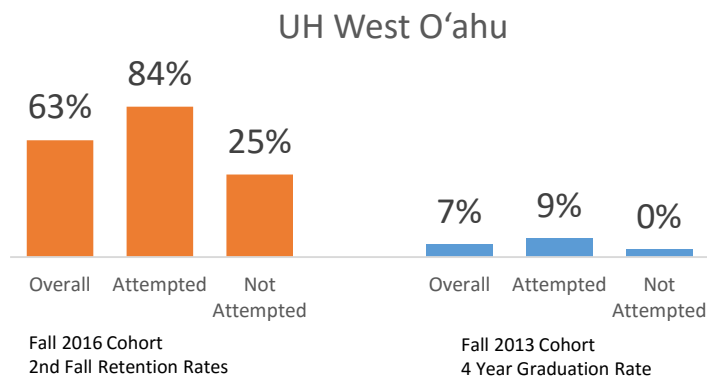
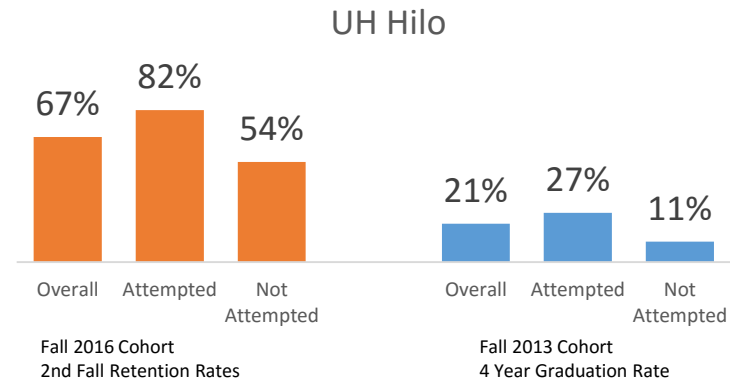
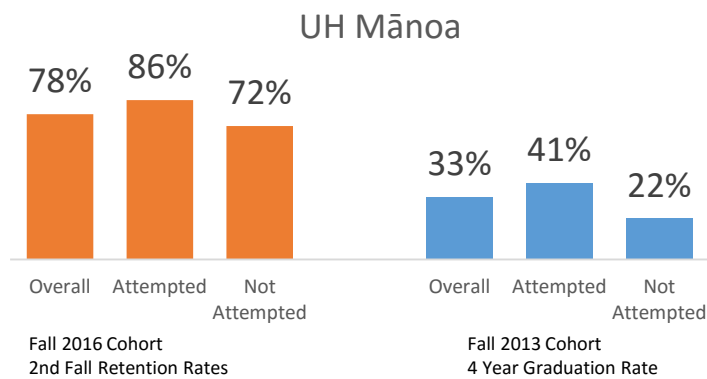
Distance Learning Course Taking Trend
