HOST 258 Hospitality Marketing - the closest match of all classes

HOST 290 Hospitality Management - though as Tom and I have looked for similar classes, TIM doesn't seem to have a close match

HOST 265 Tourism Destination Development and Planning - TIM should have something similar

HOST 152 Front Office - which used to be very similar to a course they called TIM 314 Hotel Management - used to use the same book and the first 12 weeks of the course were identical to ours - this might have changed.

HOST 154 Food and Beverage Operations - could match TIM 313 Food Service Management

HOST 261 Events Management - should match TIM 316 Special Events Management

We also just created HOST 270 Tourism Security and Safety and TIM just hired a faculty member that has this background so there could be a similar course on the horizon.

Plus...

We have added new third-year courses

HOST 320 Vacation and Condominium Hospitality Operations
HOST 330 Sustainable Hospitality Facility Design and Operations
HOST 340 Lodging Industry Analytics and Revenue Management
HOST 350 Strategic Hospitality Leadership

So these courses could provide other alignments or could fit in somewhere as an elective.
