If a student earned more than one degree, the higher degree was used.

Wage Data

Does not include those with no SSN match.

Based on state DLIR unemployment insurance (UI) and federal labor data. State UI data includes covered employees in Hawaii, and therefore excludes the self-employed, federal employees, and employees in other states. Federal labor data does not include Department of Defense employees.

If a person had more than one employer in a given time period, the industry of the employer who paid the highest wages is used, and the wage is the sum of wages from all employers.

A person is "employed" if they earned wages in all four quarters of a year.

Employment data is available at the industry level, not occupation or specific employer.






