1/ Only students whose transfer credits were accepted by the entering campus are counted in this table. In addition, if students attended more than one campus before entering Manoa, Hilo or West O'ahu, they are counted at each respective campus. Thus, the total numbers of students transferring to Manoa, Hilo or West O'ahu are duplicated to the extent that the students attended more than one prior college. The subtotal number of students transferring from the UHCCs is likewise duplicated. The unduplicated subtotal of students who attended a UHCC campus is 1,230 with 858 transferring to Manoa, 147 to Hilo, and 225 to West O'ahu. The percentages are calculated using the duplicated totals.

Note: The above methodology differs from that used previously to report transfers to UH 4-year campuses so the numbers reported here differ from transfer numbers reported previously. However, this current methodology gives a more accurate result vis a vis transfers from each UHCC to Manoa, Hilo or West O'ahu.
