Overview of programs

Kapi'olani CC

3 specializations, about 80 students, and 30 new students/year; emphasis is on AS degree; student may earn AA and transfer to UHM.

Leeward CC

has recently revised program/courses, about 85 students, 3 specializations in DMA, also ICS offers an AS in webmaster. May earn AA with ASC for transfer to ACM.

TV Pro offers CC, CA and AS, focus TV and film production.

Maui CC

has proposed AS and CC in Digital Media, with specializations in computer graphics and web design. Program to be housed in ICS; 50-60 students, currently staffed by two lecturers. Computer graphics program in review; Web design program in development.

Hawaii CC

New program, currently CC is being offered, 21 credits, 6 courses and one option course, has 6 students this Fall.

UHM

about 100 students taking courses, 12 declared majors, current receive bachelor's degree in IS; proposing BA in ACM. List of courses, both proposed and established reviewed.

Honolulu CC
