Art 112 Articulation Agreement

Leeward CC has signed agreement. Kapi'olani CC has agreed to sign agreement. Violet to follow up with Honolulu CC.

ACM Curriculum

Currently ACM requires no art prerequisites to take courses, shares lab with communication classes. Kaveh to follow up with Tom Brislin regarding: why no prerequisites required for ACM courses; why there are no 100 level courses and the possibility of having the 200 level courses offered by the CCs so that ACM can build on that foundation for their upper division courses (can ACM students be required to take required courses at non UHM campus?)

Kaveh to send other ACM course syllabi to Joanne for posting for others to view..

Separate Alpha for Digital Media courses

It was suggested that the group consider a separate alpha for digital media courses as almost all of the lower division course numbers in Art are currently "taken". Kapi'olani CC indicated that they have no objection to using a common alpha as long as the art focus is retained. However, it is quite a large scale curriculum process to make alpha changes.

Establishing New Media Arts/Digital Media Arts as a High Demand Discipline

There is need to raise salaries for faculty who teach in this discipline. The administration at Kapi'olani CC is in support of this. A systemwide approach would strengthen the case to have this approved at the BOR.

Systemwide Articulation of Programs

Discussion of how ACM program could build upon CC program. Currently, it is important for CCs to maintain their AS degree and count their graduates as this is an outcome measure for the program. Leeward CC developed an Academic Subject Certificate which is part of the AA degree. The ASC could fulfill ACM requirements in animation. The AA degree will fulfill general education core (foundation/diversification) requirements at UHM. Jan Hathaway to explore AA degree and how it might work with New Media Arts program.

There is interest to build a systemwide program between the Ccs and ACM in the animation area. This will be further explored at the next meeting in January-February 2006 when Tom Brislin will be able to join the group.
