## GPA Calculations

## Grade Point Averages

Grade point averages (GPA) are determined by dividing the total number of grade points by the total number of credit hours for which a student has received letter grades (excluding I, NC, CR, W , or I)....

## Repeating Passed Courses

...Grades for all repeated courses will be included in the GPA.

## Repeating Failed Courses

Students may repeat, for a letter grade only, any course in which an F was received. If this is done at UHM, credit hours and grade points for each attempt are included in the GPA...(UHM catalog 2004-05 p. 15)

All campuses record all repeated course grades, however some campuses drop the lower grade in the calculations of the GPA while others do not.
