TRANSFERS FROM UH COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO UH FOUR-YEAR CAMPUSES FALL 2005 TO FALL 2008

Introduction

The tables in this document show information on transfer students from the UH Community Colleges to the UH four-year campuses for the fall semesters from 2005 to 2008. Transfer students were identified by Student Type in the IRO Base census files. The population of students was restricted to classified undergraduate students with identifiable transfer credits in IRO Base.

Note: this document set was prepared upon special request by the Office of the Vice President for Academic Planning and Policy. It is not meant to replace or duplicate any report which may be published in the future by the UH Institutional Research Office and should be considered preliminary to any such report.

Duplicated Headcounts

Table 1 shows counts of students enrolled at the UH four-year campuses by institution from which students earned transfer credits. Counts are duplicated in that students with transfer credits from more than one campus are counted for each separate occurrence. Transfers from UH four-year campuses, UH Community Colleges and non-UH institutions are indicated. The small number of students enrolled at UH Mānoa with transfer credits from UH Mānoa are students with credits earned at Outreach College. Note that at present no rational strategy exists to determine which campus to designate as the previous college for those records with transfer credits from more than campus. For that reason, duplicated counts are used to determine previous college. Efforts are underway to develop a reliable methodology to determine a unique previous college for each transfer student record. The results of those efforts will be made available at a later date.

Table 2 gives the percentage of students enrolled at each four-year campus (rows) by campus from which transfer credits were earned (columns); these are <u>horizontal percentages</u>, based upon the duplicated counts given in Table 1. For example, in Fall 2008 51.3% of the transfers at UH Mānoa came from the UH Community Colleges, while 57.1% of the transfers enrolled at UH Hilo came from non-UH campuses. Similarly, 84.6% of the transfers at UH-West Oʻahu came from another UH campus.

Tables 3A through 3G provide information on the major fields of study pursued at the UH four-year campuses by students with identifiable transfer credits from the UH Community Colleges. There is one table for each UH Community College, with data for the four fall semesters from 2005 to 2008. The tables show major description and organizational structure, with duplicated headcounts by UH four-year campus. The order of the majors listing follows the organizational structure at each four-year campus. The totals shown at the bottom of the tables tie to the duplicated counts given in Table 1. Note that data for UH-West Oʻahu for Fall 2005 are not shown.


Observations and Analysis

While a few students transfer from one UH four-year campus to another, the vast majority of the transfers to the UH four-year campuses from within the UH system comes from the UH Community Colleges (Table 1; note: this study does not examine intra-UHCC transfer). Among the UHCC campuses, Kapiʻolani CC accounts for approximately one-third of all UHCC transfers; the vast majority of these transfers go to UH Mānoa. Leeward CC was second in total transfers in Fall 2008, while Honolulu CC was third. At UH Hilo, about half of all UHCC transfers come from Hawaiʻi CC, while Leeward CC accounts for the largest share of UHCC transfers at UH-West Oahu.

In Fall 2008, transfers from non-UH institutions accounted for 45% of all transfers to UH Mānoa, 57% at UH Hilo and about 15% at UH-West Oʻahu (Table 2). These numbers indicate that the non-UH component of all transfer activity is as great or in some cases greater than the UHCC component. (Note: Information on the number of institutions represented in the non-UH count is not readily available.)

Overall, the number of transfers appears to be fairly stable at UH Mānoa, declining at UH Hilo (at least since Fall 2005) and increasing at UH-West Oahu. Transfers from non-UH institutions have been declining at both UH Mānoa and UH Hilo since Fall 2005. Transfers from the UH Community Colleges appear stable at UH Mānoa, stable to slightly increasing at UH Hilo (since Fall 2006), and increasing at UH-West Oahu. With the addition of lower division students at UH-West Oahu, beginning in Fall 2007, additional growth in transfers from all sources at that campus is anticipated.

Percentage of Total UHCC Transfers to UH Four-Year Campuses by UHCC Campus of Origin - Fall 2008


