SUBJECT: FALL 2008 PRELIMINARY OPENING ENROLLMENTS—ALL **CREDIT PROGRAMS**

I am pleased to announce that the fall 2008 opening enrollment for the University of Hawai'i system reached an all-time record of 53,509-the highest in the institution's history-a year after its centennial anniversary. The previous opening enrollment high was in fall 1994 at 52,229. Since then, enrollment dipped to the 44,000 level in 2000 before increasing to and remaining at the 50,000 level for the past five years. 2008 preliminary opening credit enrollment figures increased by 2,705 students (+5.3%) compared to last fall.

These enrollment figures are ready for distribution. Draft press comments are enclosed for use as appropriate.

FALL 2008 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 53,509 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects an increase (+2,705, 5.3%) in student enrollment than at a comparable date in 2007. UH Hilo, UH West O'ahu, and the UH Community Colleges experienced increases in enrollment while UH Mānoa experienced a slight decrease from a year ago.

Separately, approximately 27,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

Highlights:


- UH's fall 2008 opening enrollment of 53,509 is the highest in the institution's history. Opening enrollment has remained at the 50,000 level from fall 2003 through fall 2007.
- UH Mānoa's enrollment stands at 19,969, 37 or 0.2% fewer students than at a comparable date in fall 2007.
- UH Hilo's opening fall enrollment increased to 3,786, with a gain of 178 students, or 4.9%.
- UH West O'ahu's opening credit enrollment increased to 1,163, with a gain of 192 (19.8%) compared to a year ago. The campus enrolled its second freshman class in fall 2008.
- UH Community College enrollment stands at 28,591, with an increase of 2,372 or 9.0%. All seven campuses reported increases ranging from 2.7%–14.0%.
- The Leeward campus posted the largest numerical gain with 843 students followed by Kapi'olani with 671 students. The Mānoa campus posted the only numerical loss with 37 fewer students.
- The greatest percentage gains in enrollments were at UH West O'ahu (19.8%), Hawai'i CC (14.0%), and Leeward CC (13.9%).
