SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY OPENING SPRING 2007 ENROLLMENTS-ALL

CREDIT PROGRAMS

It is a pleasure to share with you the 2007 opening spring enrollments at all campuses of the University of Hawai'i system. These preliminary opening credit enrollment figures show that the University system enrollment of 46,308 is 84 or -0.2% less than at a comparable date last spring. The UH system experienced increases in its spring headcount enrollment from 2002 through 2005 before experiencing slight decreases in spring 2006 and 2007.

These enrollment figures are ready for distribution. Draft highlights for a press release are enclosed for use as appropriate.

SPRING 2007 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

University of Hawai'i spring enrollments have remained stable at 46,000. Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 46,308 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects 84, or 0.2 percent fewer student enrollments than at a comparable date in spring 2006.

Separately, more than 27,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

Highlights:

- UH system enrollment has declined slightly after experiencing four years of growth since 2002. The decline, however, is relatively modest, with most campuses having 0–2 percent decreases in spring 2007.
- UH Mānoa's enrollment stands at 18,959, with 122 or 0.6% fewer students than at a comparable date in spring 2006.
- UH Hilo's opening spring enrollment increased to 3,287, with a gain of 18 students or 0.6%, relative to a year ago.
- UH West O'ahu's enrollment stands at 820, an increase of 17 (2.1%) over the previous year.
- UH Community College enrollment remains steady at 23,242, up by 3 (0.0%) from spring 2006. Enrollments increased slightly at Kapi'olani CC and Hawai'i CC while enrollments decreased slightly at the remaining five community colleges.
- The largest numerical increase was at Kapi'olani CC (+167) and the largest numerical decrease was at Mānoa (-122).
- The largest percentage increase was at Kapi'olani CC (+2.5%) followed by UH West O'ahu (+2.1%). The largest percentage decrease was at Windward CC (-3.9%).
