

**SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY OPENING SPRING 2004 ENROLLMENTS—ALL
CREDIT PROGRAMS**

It is a pleasure to share with you the 2004 opening spring enrollments at all campuses of the University of Hawai'i system. These preliminary opening credit enrollment figures show that the University system enrollment of 46,814 is 1,021 or 2.2% more than at a comparable date last spring. The UH system has experienced steady enrollment increases since spring 2002.

These enrollment figures are ready for distribution. Draft press comments are enclosed for use as appropriate.

SPRING 2004 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

University of Hawai'i enrollments are up at seven of the ten campuses. Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 46,814 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects 1,021, or 2.2 percent more student enrollments than at a comparable date in spring 2003.

It is expected that another 32,000 students will be enrolling in non-credit programs throughout the UH system, bringing the total enrollment to more than 78,000.

Highlights:

- ! UH system enrollment has steadily increased since spring 2002.
- ! UH Mānoa's enrollment stands at 18,448, 590 or 3.3% more students than at a comparable date in spring 2003.
- ! UH Hilo's opening spring enrollment stands at 3,117, an increase of 137 students or 4.6%.
- ! UH-West O'ahu's opening credit enrollment stands at 825, increasing by 19 or 2.4% compared to a year ago.
- ! UH Community College enrollment stands at 24,424, up 1.1%. Four of seven campuses reported increases ranging from 2.1%–17.3%. Three campuses, Honolulu, Kaua'i and Maui, reported decreases (-6.8%, -2.2% and -3.9%, respectively).
- ! The Mānoa campus posted the largest numerical gain with 590 students. This was followed by the University campuses Hawai'i (319), Kapi'olani (189) and Leeward (168).
- ! The greatest percentage gains in enrollments were at the University campuses Hawai'i (17.3%), Hilo (4.6%), and Mānoa (3.3%).
- ! There are approximately 41,000 undergraduate and 5,800 graduate students attending UH in spring 2004.
