I am pleased to announce that the fall 2011 opening enrollment for the University of Hawai'i system reached yet another high in our institution's history at 60,519. It increases slightly from fall 2010's record enrollment of 60,231 (+288, 0.5%). Compared to five years ago, over 10,000 more students are attending our University of Hawai'i campuses today.

### **FALL 2011 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS**

Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 60,519 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects an increase of 288 (+0.5%) in student enrollment than at a comparable date in 2010. UH Mānoa, UH Hilo, and UH West O'ahu experienced increases in enrollment while the UH Community Colleges experienced a slight decrease from a year ago.

Separately, approximately 28,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

# **Highlights:**

- For a fourth year in a row, UH's fall opening enrollment is at an all-time high at 60,519. After remaining at 50,000 for five years, enrollment has increased significantly. In the past five years, enrollment has grown by 20 percent.
- UH Mānoa experienced a slight increase in enrollment. It stands at 20,313, 176 or 0.9% more students than at a comparable date in fall 2010.
- UH Hilo's opening fall enrollment increased to 4,149, with a gain of 64 students, or 1.6%.
- UH West O'ahu's opening credit enrollment increased significantly to 1,699, with a gain of 205 (13.7%) compared to a year ago. The campus enrolled its fifth freshman class in fall 2011.
- UH Community College enrollment is at 34,358, decreasing slightly by 157 or 0.5% from last fall. Three campuses reported increases ranging from 2.2%–3.9%. Four campuses reported decreases ranging from 0.6%–3.3%.
- UH West O'ahu posted the largest numerical gain with 205 students followed by UH Mānoa (176) and Maui College (168).
- UH West O'ahu also posted the largest percentage gain with an increase of 13.7%.
- Fall 2011's enrollment reflects an increase of 10,209 (20.3%) over a five year period. Much of that growth has been at UH West O'ahu (+802, 89.4%) and at the UH Community Colleges (+8,769, +34.3%).
