SUBJECT: FALL 2012 PRELIMINARY OPENING ENROLLMENTS—ALL

CREDIT PROGRAMS

I am pleased to announce that the fall 2012 opening enrollment for the University of Hawai'i system reached yet another high in our institution's history at 60,633. It increased slightly from fall 2011's record enrollment of 60,519 (+114, 0.2%). Compared to six years ago, over 10,000 more students are attending our University of Hawai'i campuses today; an increase of 21%.

FALL 2012 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 60,633 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects an increase of 114 (+0.2%) in student enrollment than at a comparable date in 2011. UH Mānoa, UH Hilo, and UH West O'ahu experienced increases in enrollment while the UH Community Colleges experienced a decrease from a year ago.

Separately, approximately 20,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

Highlights:

- For a fifth year in a row, UH's fall opening enrollment reached a new all-time high of 60,633. After remaining at 50,000 for a number of years, enrollment has increased significantly. Since 2006, enrollment has grown by 21 percent.
- UH Mānoa's fall opening enrollment remained about the same compared to a year ago. It stands at 20,320, seven or 0.03% more students than at a comparable date in fall 2011.
- UH Hilo's fall opening enrollment increased slightly to 4,172, with a gain of 23 students, or 0.6%.
- UH West O'ahu's enrollment increased significantly to 2,023, with a gain of 324 (19.1%) compared to a year ago. UHWO began holding classes at a new campus this semester.
- UH Community College enrollment is at 34,118, decreasing slightly by 240 or 0.7% from last fall. Three campuses reported increases ranging from 1.2%–5.4%. Four campuses reported decreases ranging from 0.1%–6.3%.
- UH West O'ahu posted the largest numerical gain with 324 students. UHWO is the only campus to gain more than 100 students.
- UH West O'ahu also posted the largest percentage gain with an increase of 19.1%.
- Fall 2012's enrollment reflects an increase of 10,323 (20.5%) over a six year period. Much of that growth has been at UH West O'ahu (+1,126, 125.5%) and at the UH Community Colleges (+8,529, +33.3%).
