SUBJECT: FALL 2013 PRELIMINARY OPENING ENROLLMENTS—ALL CREDIT PROGRAMS

The fall 2013 opening enrollment for the University of Hawai'i system is 59,288, a decrease from fall 2012's record high enrollment of 60,633 (-1,345, -2.2%). This decrease comes after reaching new all-time high enrollments in each of the last five years.

These enrollment figures are ready for distribution. Draft press comments are enclosed for use as appropriate.

FALL 2013 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 59,288 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects a decrease of 1,345 (-2.2%) in student enrollment than at a comparable date in 2012. UH West O'ahu experienced an increase in enrollment while UH Mānoa, UH Hilo, and the UH Community Colleges experienced a decrease from a year ago.

Separately, approximately 15,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

Highlights:

- UH's fall opening enrollment has decreased to 59,288. This decrease comes after reaching new all-time high enrollments in each of the last five years. Since 2007, enrollment has grown by 17 percent.
- UH Mānoa's fall opening enrollment stands at 19,912, decreasing by 408 or 2.0%, from fall 2012.
- UH Hilo's fall opening enrollment decreased to 4,034, with a loss of 138 students, or 3.3%.
- UH West O'ahu's enrollment increased significantly to 2,403, with a gain of 380 (18.8%) compared to a year ago. UHWO began holding classes at a new campus last fall.
- UH Community College enrollment is at 32,939, decreasing by 1,179 or 3.5% from fall 2012. Three colleges, Kaua'i, Leeward and Windward, reported increases ranging from 0.4%–2.2%. Four colleges reported decreases ranging from 4.6%–6.6%.
- UH West O'ahu posted the largest numerical gain with 380 students. UHWO is the only campus to gain more than 100 students.
- UH West O'ahu also posted the largest percentage gain with an increase of 18.8%.
- Fall 2013's enrollment reflects an increase of 8,484 (16.7%) over a six year period. Much of that growth has been at UH West O'ahu (+1,432, 147.5%) and at the UH Community Colleges (+6,720, +25.6%).
