SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY OPENING SPRING 2011 ENROLLMENTS—ALL

CREDIT PROGRAMS

I am pleased to announce that the Spring 2011 opening enrollment for the University of Hawai'i system reached an all-time record of 56,716—the highest spring enrollment in the institution's history. The previous opening enrollment high for spring was in 2010 at 55,761. The 2011 preliminary opening credit enrollment figures increased by 955 students (1.7%) compared to Spring 2010 and by 5,764 (11.3%) compared to Spring 2009.

These enrollment figures are ready for distribution. Draft highlights for a press release are enclosed for use as appropriate.

SPRING 2011 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

University of Hawai'i spring enrollments increased at seven of ten campuses. Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 56,716 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects 955, or 1.7 percent, more student enrollments than at a comparable date in Spring 2010.

Separately, more than 20,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

Highlights:

- UH system enrollment has increased for a fourth straight year after experiencing two years of decreases in 2006 and 2007. Since 2007, spring enrollment has increased 10,408, or 22.5 percent.
- UH Mānoa, Honolulu CC, and Kaua'i CC posted slight decreases in Spring 2011. The other seven campuses experienced increases ranging from 1.1% to 9.8%.
- UH Mānoa's enrollment stands at 19,242, with 44 or 0.2% less students than at a comparable date in Spring 2010.
- UH Hilo's opening spring enrollment increased to 3,961, with a gain of 97 students or 2.5%, relative to a year ago.
- UH West O'ahu's enrollment stands at 1,403, an increase of 125 (9.8%) over the previous year.
- UH Community College enrollment increased to 32,110, up by 777 (2.5%) from Spring 2010.
- The largest numerical increases were at Hawai'i CC (+301), Maui College (+212), and Leeward CC (+187).
- The largest percentage increases were at UH West O'ahu (+9.8%), Hawai'i CC (+9.3%), and Windward CC (+6.9%).
