SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY OPENING SPRING 2012 ENROLLMENTS—ALL CREDIT PROGRAMS

I would like to share with you the Spring 2012 opening enrollment for all campuses of the University of Hawai'i system. After reaching an all-time high of 56,716 in Spring 2011, UH's Spring 2012 opening enrollment is 56,676, down 40 enrollments or -0.1%. Despite the slight decline, our current Spring 2012 enrollment is the second highest spring opening enrollment in UH's history.

These enrollment figures are ready for distribution. Draft highlights for a press release are enclosed for use as appropriate.

SPRING 2012 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

University of Hawai'i spring enrollments increased at six of ten campuses. Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 56,676 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects 40, or 0.1 percent, fewer student enrollments than at a comparable date in Spring 2011.

Separately, more than 20,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

Highlights:

- UH system enrollment has decreased for the first time after experiencing four straight years of increases from 2008 to 2011.
- UH Mānoa, Honolulu CC, Kapi'olani CC, and Kaua'i CC posted slight decreases in Spring 2012 ranging from -0.1% to -4.0%. The other six campuses experienced increases ranging from 0.1% to 13.5%.
- UH Mānoa's enrollment stands at 19,155, with 87 or 0.5% fewer students than at a comparable date in Spring 2011.
- UH Hilo's opening spring enrollment increased to 4,003, with a gain of 42 students or 1.1%, relative to a year ago.
- UH West O'ahu's enrollment stands at 1,593, an increase of 190 (13.5%) over the previous year.
- UH Community College enrollment decreased to 31,925, down by 185 (0.6%) from Spring 2011.
- The largest numerical increases were at UH West O'ahu (+190) and Windward CC (+145).
- The largest percentage increases were also at UH West O'ahu (+13.5%) and Windward CC (+5.9%).


