SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY OPENING SPRING 2013 ENROLLMENTS—ALL CREDIT PROGRAMS

I would like to share with you the spring 2013 opening enrollment for all campuses of the University of Hawai'i system. The University's preliminary opening credit enrollment stands at 55,373, a decline of 1,303 or -2.3% from last spring. This is the second year opening enrollment figures have decreased slightly after reaching an all-time record high of 56,716 Spring 2011.

These enrollment figures are ready for distribution. Draft highlights for a press release are enclosed for use as appropriate.

SPRING 2013 OPENING ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

University of Hawai'i spring enrollments decreased at eight of ten campuses. Preliminary opening credit enrollment figures indicate that 55,373 students have registered for classes on all campuses of the University of Hawai'i. This number reflects 1,303, or 2.3 percent, fewer student enrollments than at a comparable date in spring 2012.

Separately, more than 15,000 registrations in non-credit programs are expected throughout the UH system.

Highlights:

- UH system enrollments decreased slightly for the second year after experiencing four consecutive years of increases from spring 2008 to spring 2011.
- UH West O'ahu (+344, 21.6%) and Kaua'i CC (+41, 3.1%) were the two UH campuses that had increases in their spring 2013 opening enrollment.
- UH Mānoa's enrollment has been remained stable at 19,073, with 82 or 0.4% fewer students than at a comparable date in spring 2012.
- UH Hilo's opening spring enrollment decreased to 3,901, with a decrease of 102 students or -2.5%, relative to a year ago.
- UH West O'ahu's enrollment stands at 1,937, an increase of 344 (21.6%) over the previous year. The campus moved to its new and expanded Kapolei site in fall 2013.
- UH Community College enrollment decreased to 30,462, down by 1,463 (-4.6%) from spring 2012.
- Decreases at nine UH Community College campuses ranged from 2.2% at Leeward CC to 9.0% at Hawai'i CC.


