The AA in Teaching degree program gives students the opportunity to jumpstart their study of education by offering education courses with embedded field experiences in their freshman and sophomore years. This helps students to make an earlier informed decision as to whether education as a career is right for them.

1. At least 12 of the 62 credits must be earned at Leeward CC.
2. All 62 credits must be in courses numbered 100 or higher.
3. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher for all courses numbered 100 or above completed at Leeward CC.
