Discussions with the UHM Art Department regarding course articulation have resulted in agreements on the following courses for UHCC's who wish to have their art courses accepted as fulfilling program requirements at the UHM's Department of Art & Art History (DAAH):

- 1. Art 123 (Intro to Painting) will remain at that number at UHM, if all UHCC campuses have Art 113 (Basic Drawing) as a prerequisite to their Art 123.
- 2. Art 214 (Life Drawing) will have Art 113 as a prerequisite.
- 3. Art 223 (Intermediate Painting) will remain at that number at UHM, if all UHCC campuses have Art 123 as a prerequisite to their Art 223.
- 4. Art 324 (Painting from Life) will return to Art 224 (Painting from Life), if all UHCC campuses have Art 214 and Art 223 as prerequisites to their Art 224.
- 5. Art 290 (Art of Africa, Pacific, North America) will be accepted at UHM as equivalent to UHM's Art 390 (Art of Africa, Pacific, North America), if those UHCC campuses that offer Art 290 have Art 176 (Survey of Global Art II) as a pre-requisite.

Relative to the above, the below UHCC's offer the following art course with these pre-requisites:

To facilitate and maintain articulation of art courses with UHM's DAAH, it is recommended that all UHCC's who teach, or wish to teach Art 123, 223, 224, and 290 adopt the following prerequisites:

- 1. Add 113 as a pre-reg to their Art 123 classes.
- 2. Add Art 223 to the pre-reg of 214 for Art 224 (Life Painting).
- 3. Add Art 176\* as a pre-reg for Art 290.

\*For UHCC campuses that do not offer Art 175 or 176, UHM's DAAH currently accepts the following UHCC art history courses of Art 270: *Intro to Western Art*, Art 280: *Intro to Eastern Art*, and Art 290: *Intro to the Arts of Africa, North America, and the Pacific* as fulfilling the below respective program requirements:

- •UHCC's Art 280 or 290 will be accepted at UHM's DAAH as Art 175 or 176
- UHCC's Art 270 and 280 or 290 will be accepted at UHM's DAAH as Art 175 and 176 (e.g. UHCC's Art 270 and 280 will be accepted as Art 175 and 176)
   (e.g. UHCC's Art 270 and 290 will be accepted as Art 175 and 176)
- •UHCC's Art 270, 280 and 290 = UHM ART 175, 176 and one Art elective.

For campuses that wish to continue to teach Intro to Western Art and Intro to Eastern Art and have them count towards program requirements at UHM's DAAH, it is recommended that if those courses are not at the 200 level, then curriculum modification proposals should be submitted to each campus' Curriculum Committees to change the course numbers from Art 170 to Art 270 and from Art 180 to Art 280 to align with other UHCC art history course numbering.
