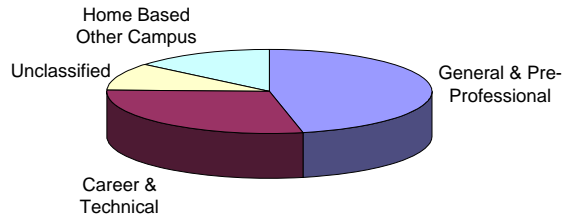


Table 2. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2006

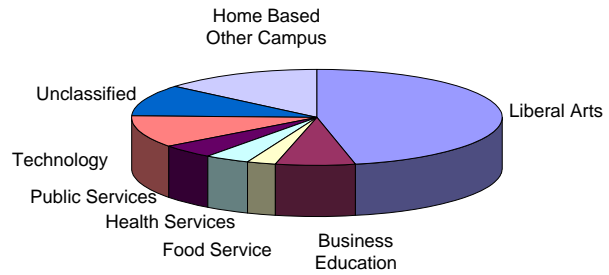

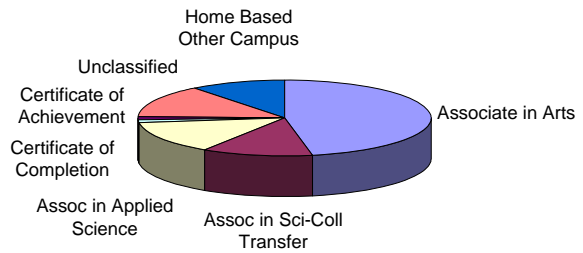


Table 4. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2006

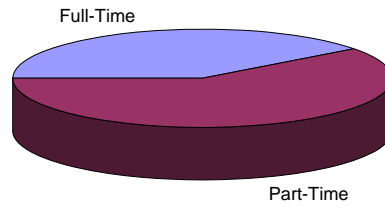


Table 5. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

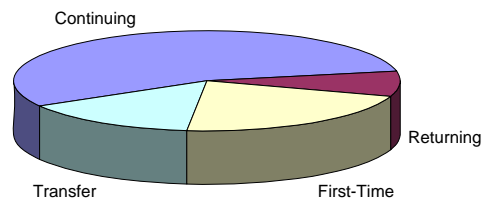


Table 6. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

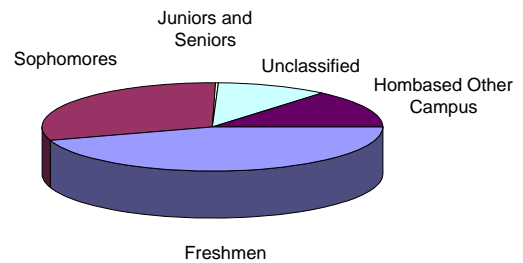


Table 7. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2006

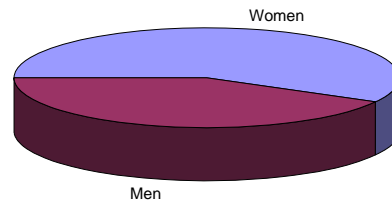


Table 8. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

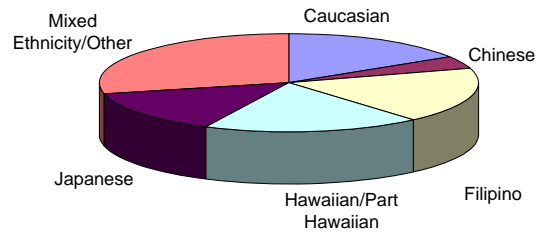


Table 9. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Age, Fall 2006

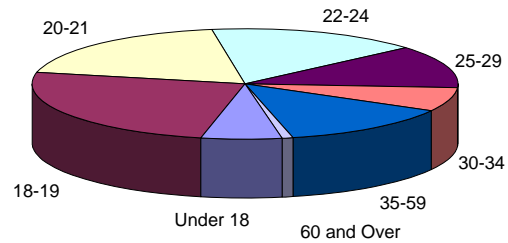


Table 10. UH Community Colleges Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

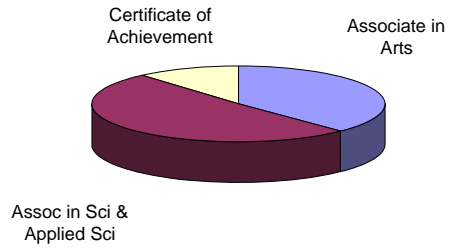


Table 11. UH Community Colleges Last Term Enrolled Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

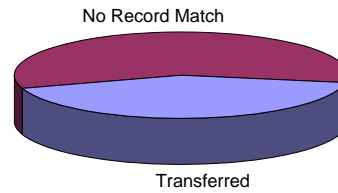


Table 12. UH Community College Transfers Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

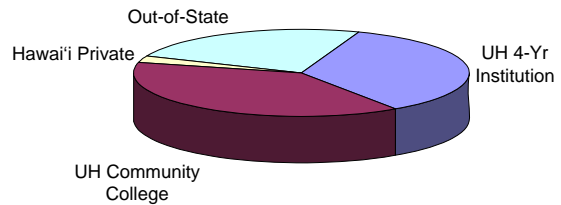


Table 13. UH Community Colleges Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2006

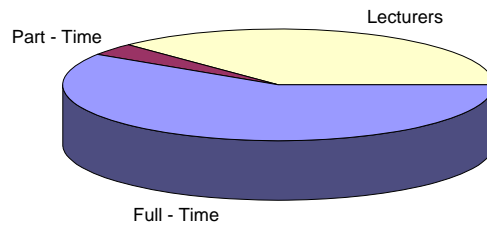


Table 14. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

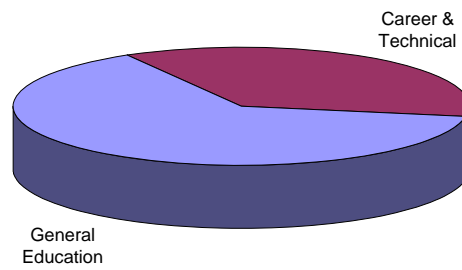


Table 15. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

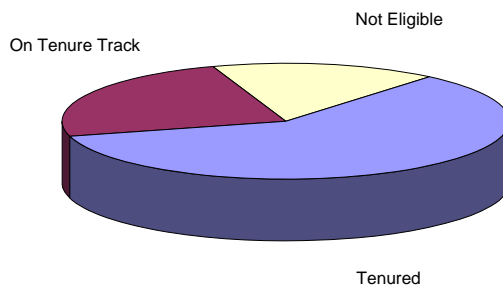


Table 16. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2006

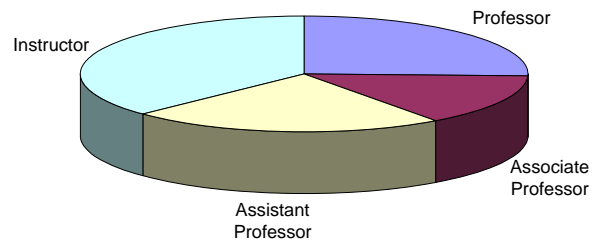


Table 17. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

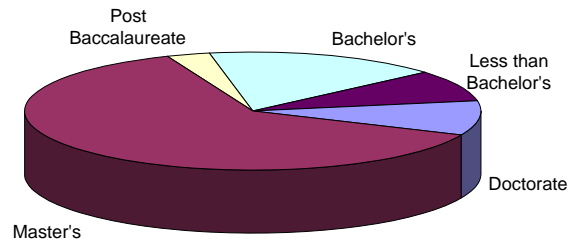


Table 18. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2006

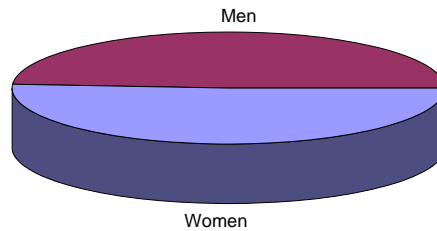
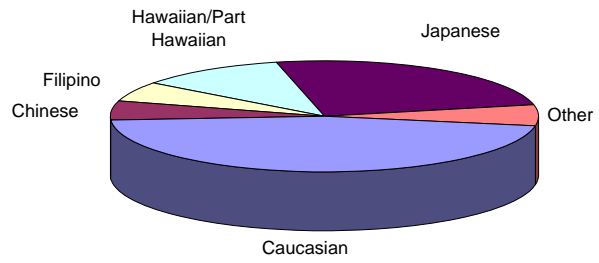

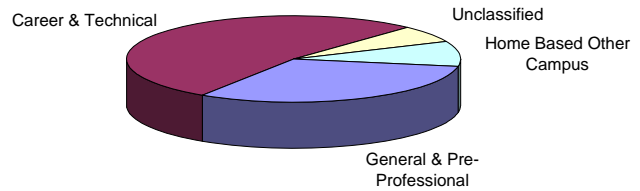


Table 2. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2006

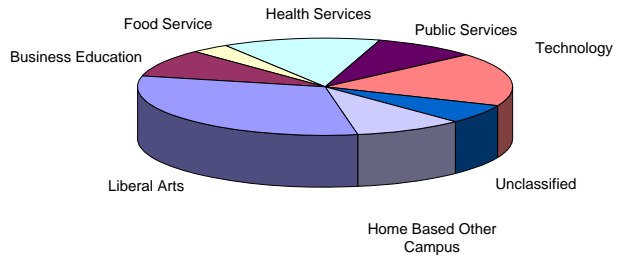


Table 3. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2006

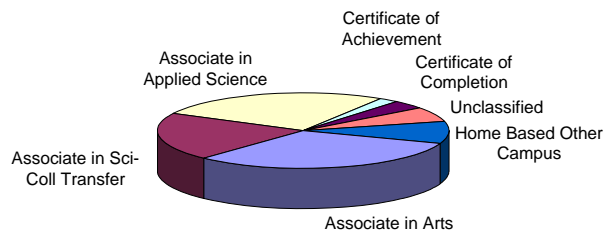


Table 4. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2006

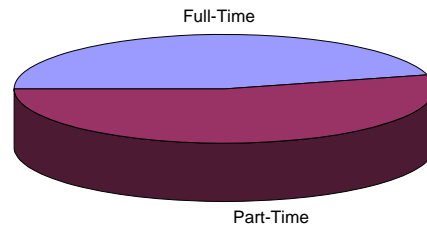


Table 5. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

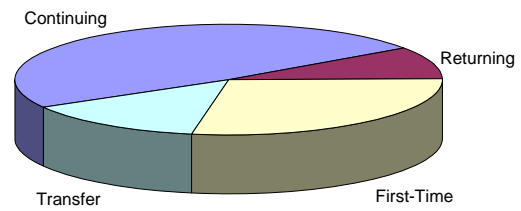


Table 6. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

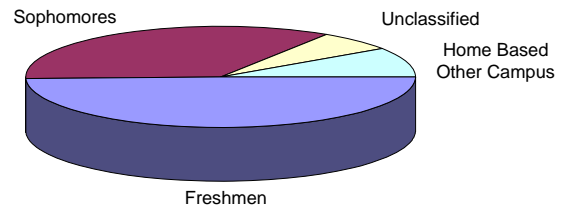


Table 7. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2006

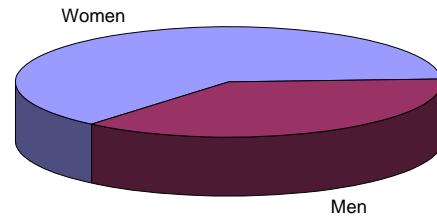


Table 8. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

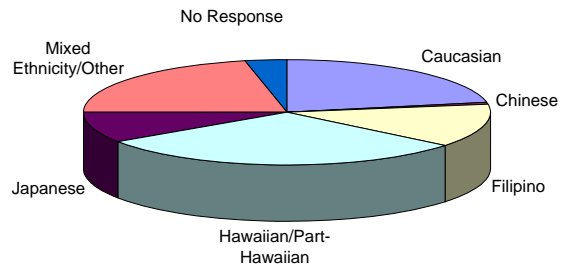


Table 9. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2006

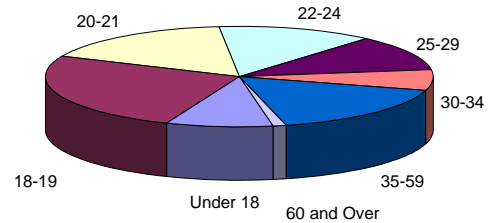


Table 10. Hawai'i Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

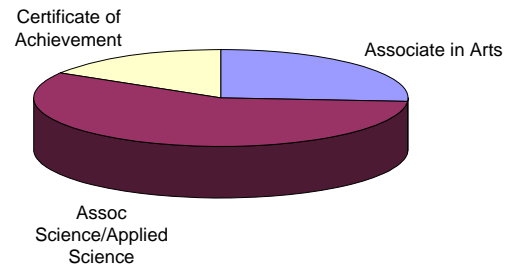


Table 11. Hawai'i Community College Students Last Term Attended Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

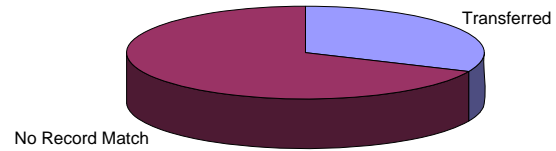


Table 12. Hawai'i Community College Transfer Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

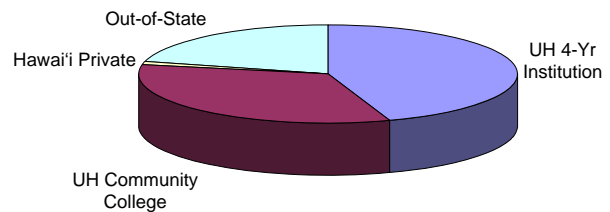


Table 13. Hawai'i Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2006

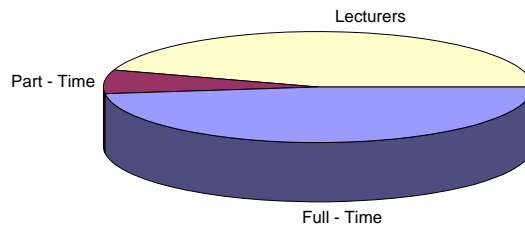


Table 14. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

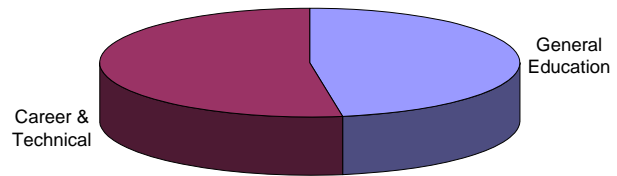


Table 15. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

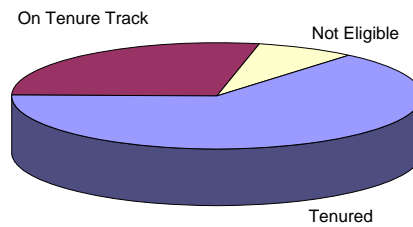


Table 16. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2006

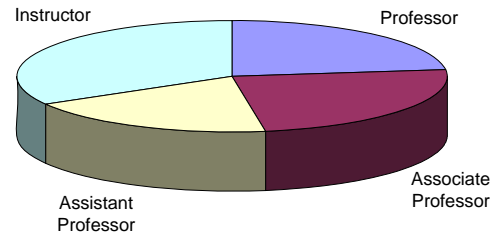


Table 17. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

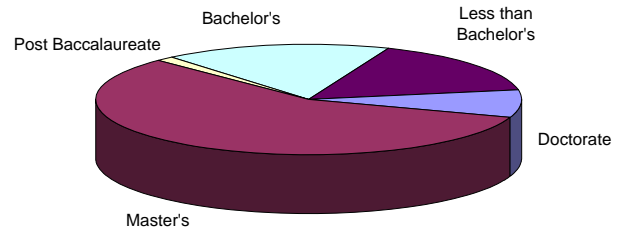


Table 18. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2006

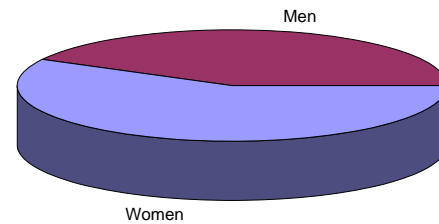
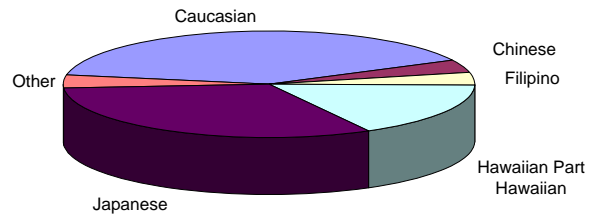


Table 19. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

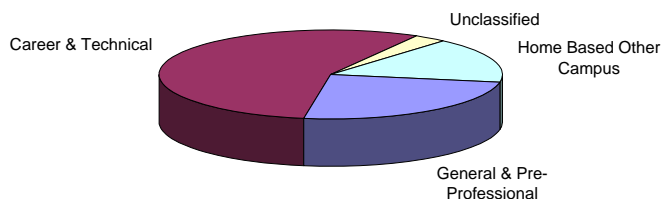


Table 2. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2006

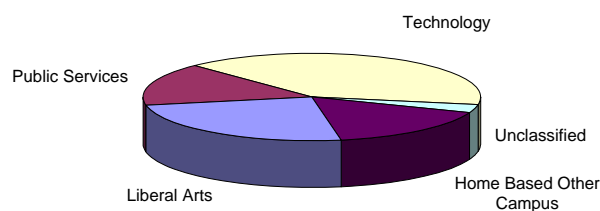


Table 3. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2006

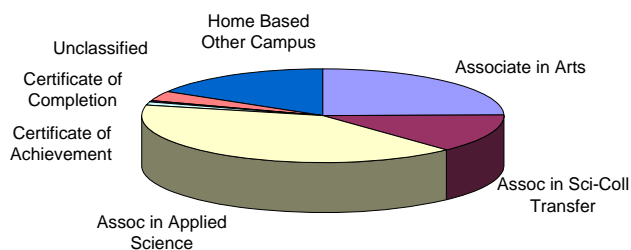


Table 4. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2006

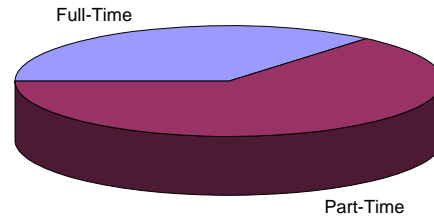


Table 5. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

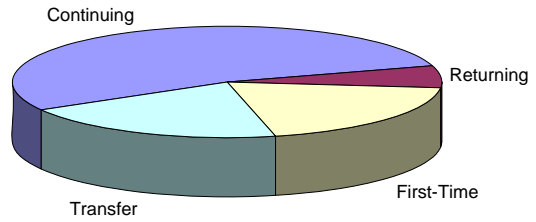


Table 6. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

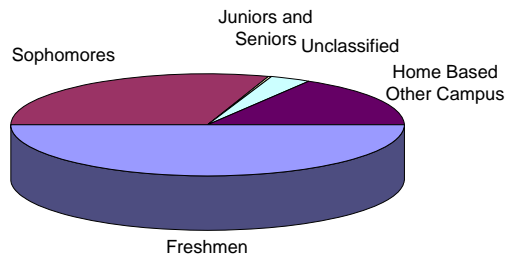




Table 7. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2006

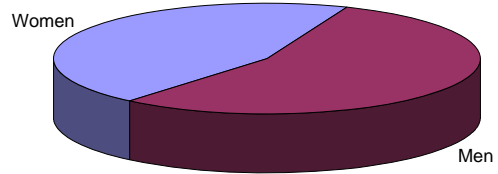


Table 8. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

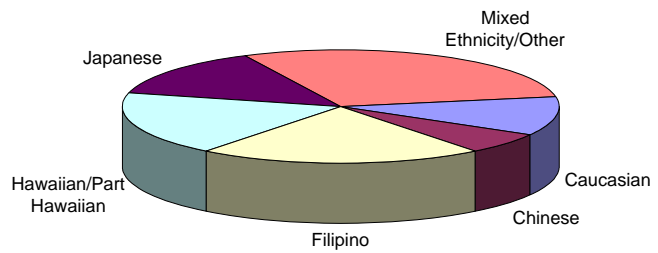


Table 9. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2006

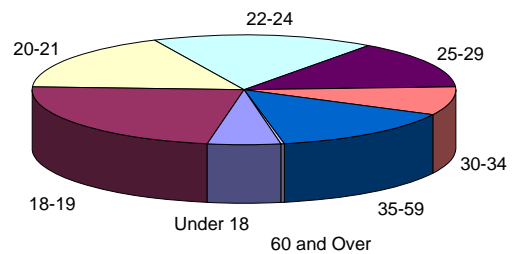


Table 10. Honolulu Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

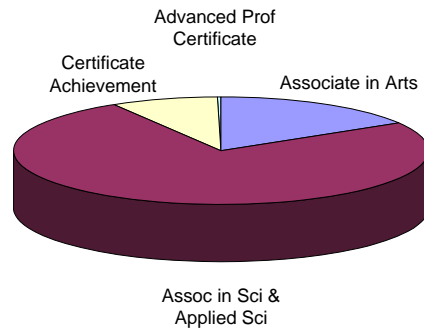


Table 11. Honolulu Community College Last Term Attended Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

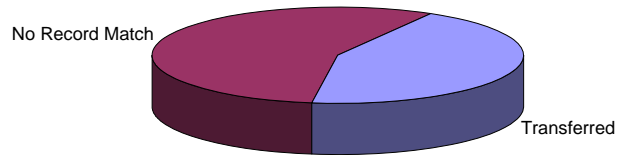


Table 12. Honolulu Community College Transfers Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

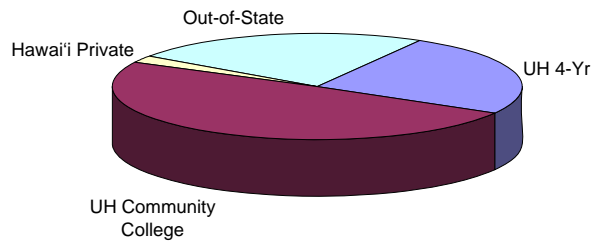


Table 13. Honolulu Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2006

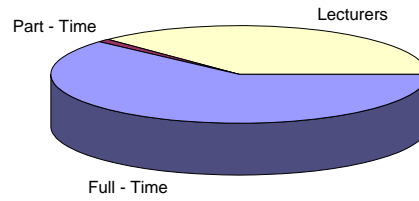


Table 14. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

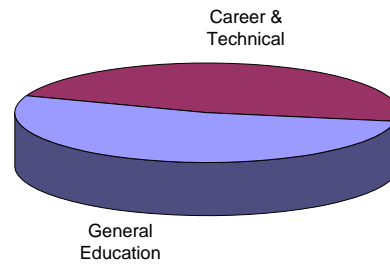


Table 15. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

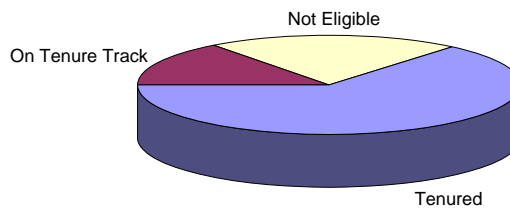


Table 16. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2006

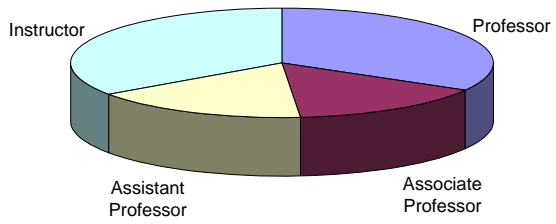


Table 17. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

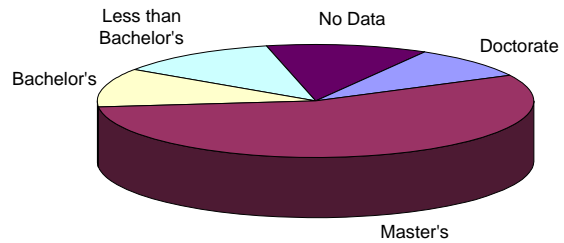


Table 18. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2006

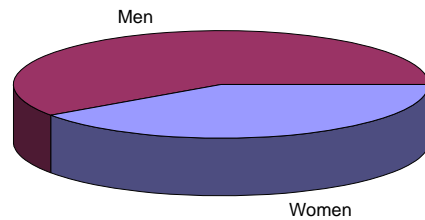
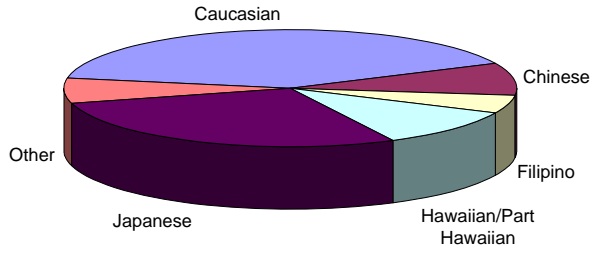


Table 19. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

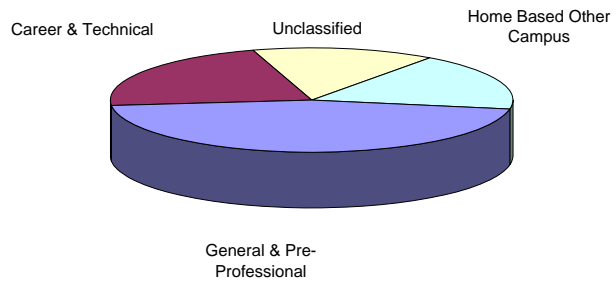


Table 2. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2006

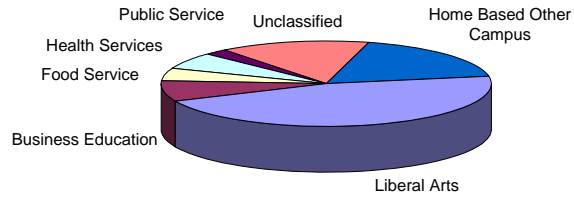


Table 3. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2006

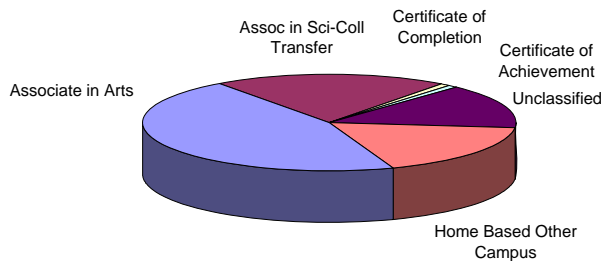


Table 4. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2006

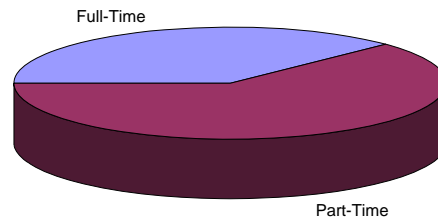


Table 5. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

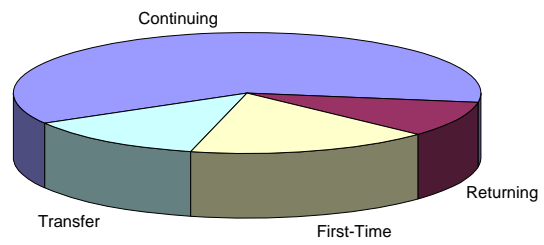


Table 6. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

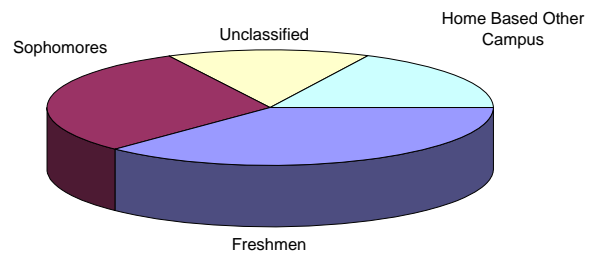


Table 7. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2006

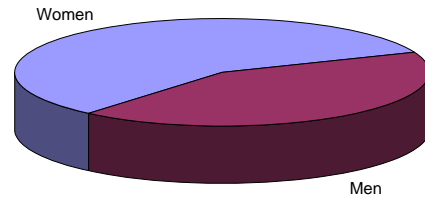


Table 8. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

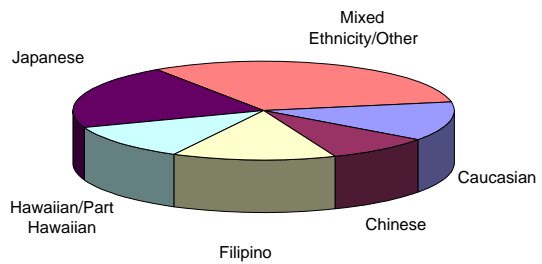


Table 9. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2006

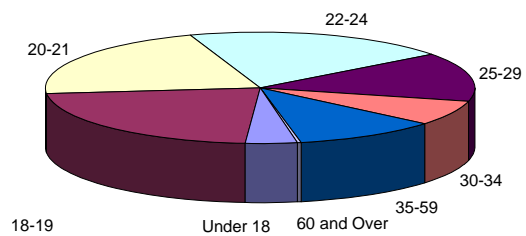


Table 10. Kapi'olani Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

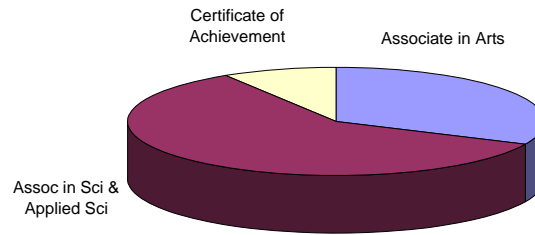


Table 11. Kapi'olani Community College Students Last Term Attended Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

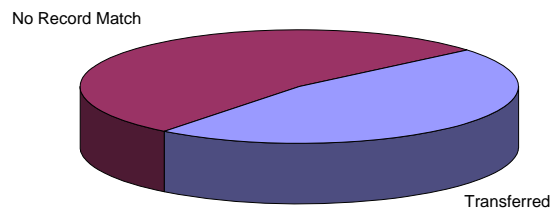


Table 12. Kapi'olani Community College Transfers Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

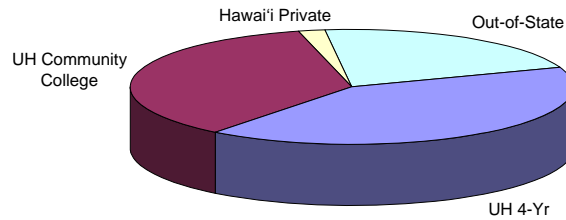

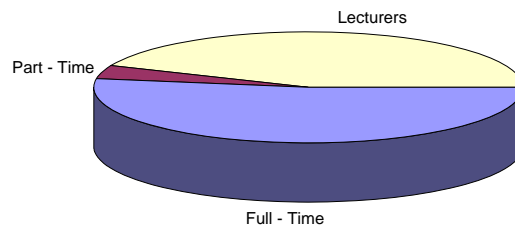


Table 14. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

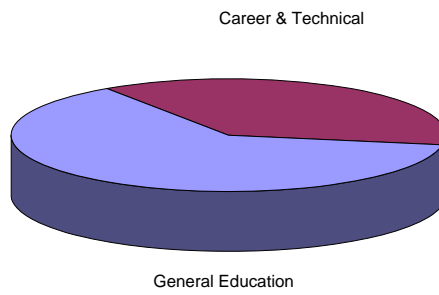


Table 15. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

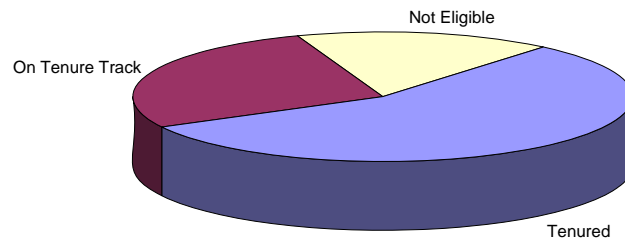


Table 16. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2006

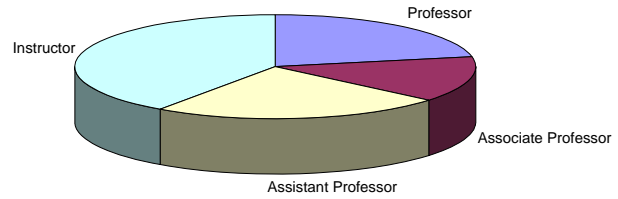


Table 17. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

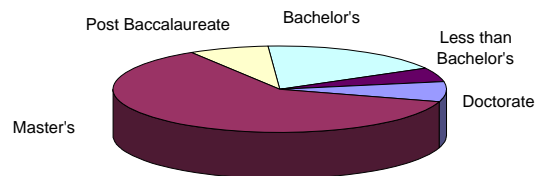


Table 18. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2006

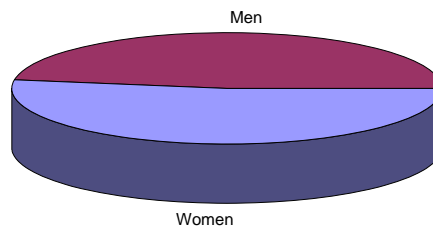
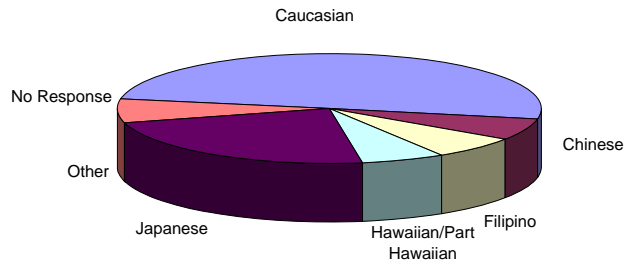


Table 19. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

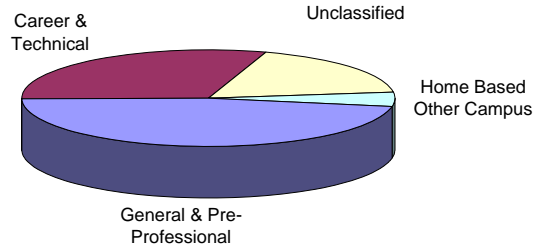

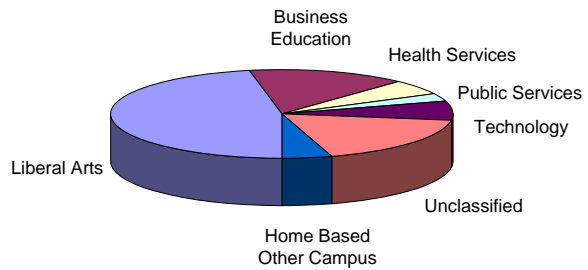


Table 3. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2006

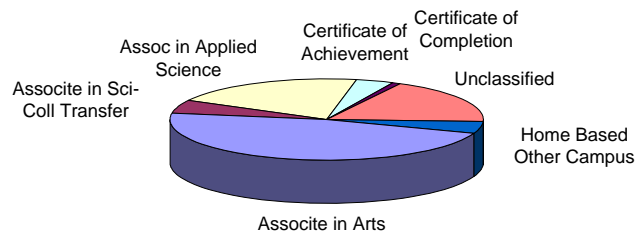




Table 4. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2006

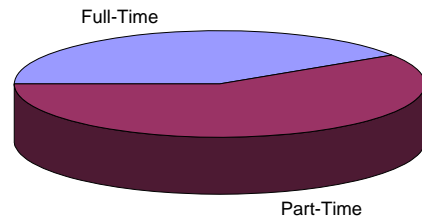


Table 5. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

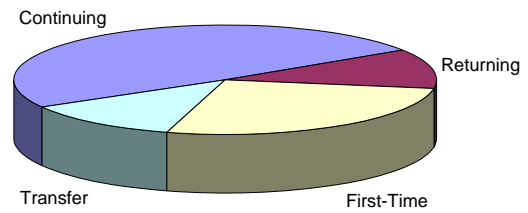


Table 6. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

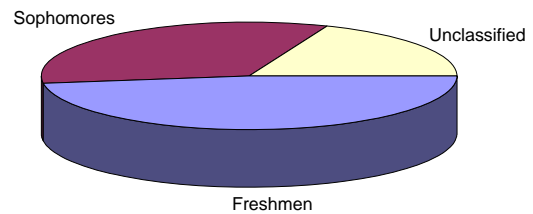


Table 7. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2006

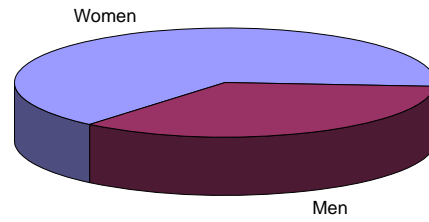


Table 8. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

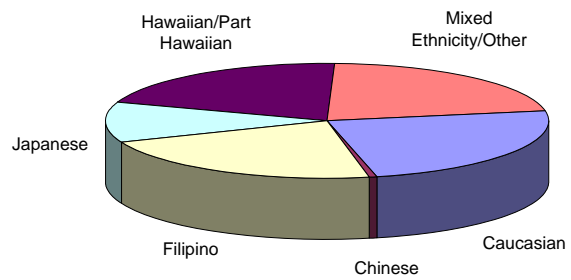


Table 9. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2006

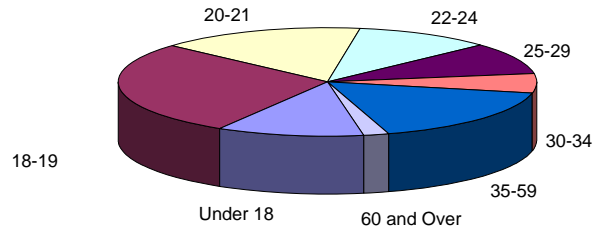


Table 10. Kaua'i Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

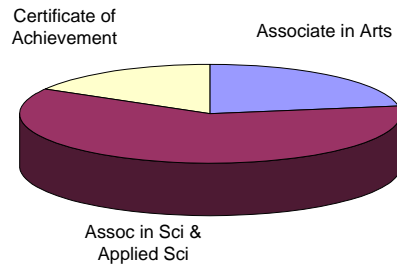


Table 11. Kaua'i Community College Students Last Attended Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

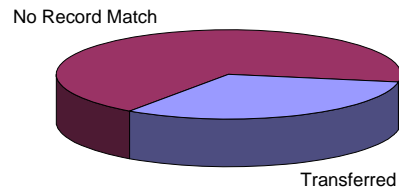


Table 12. Kaua'i Community College Transfers Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

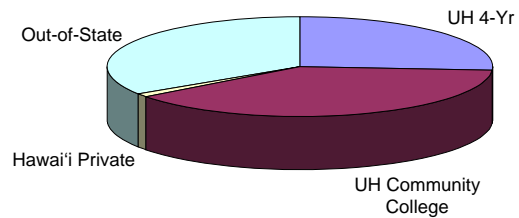


Table 13. Kaua'i Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2006

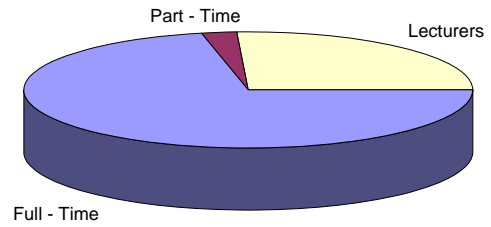


Table 14. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

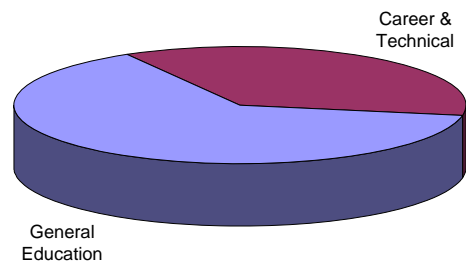


Table 15. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

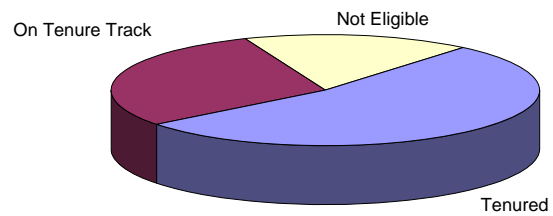


Table 16. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2006

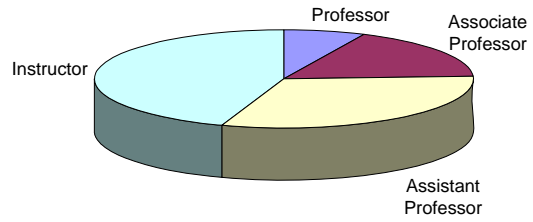


Table 17. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

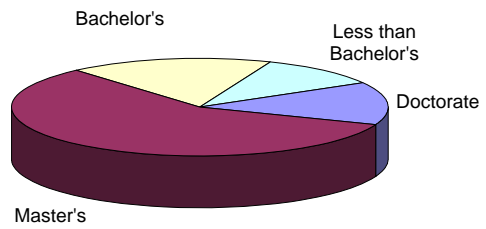


Table 18. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2006

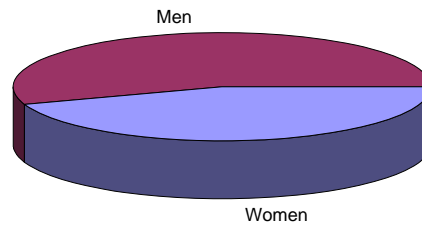
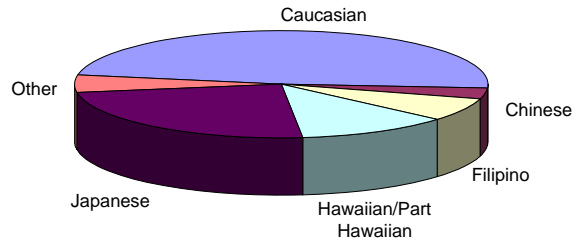


Table 19. Kaua'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

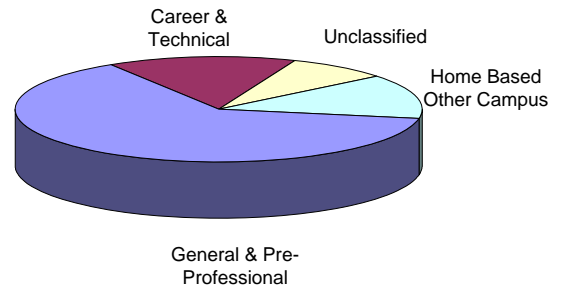

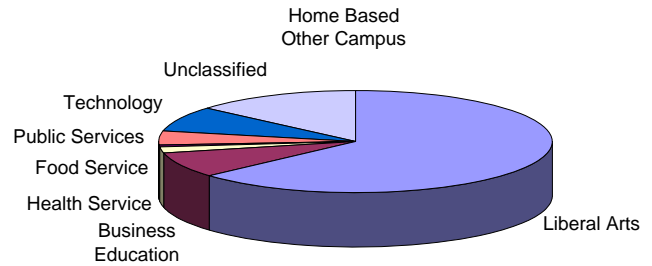


Table 3. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2006

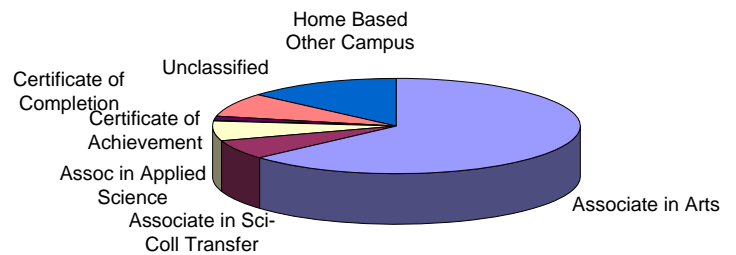

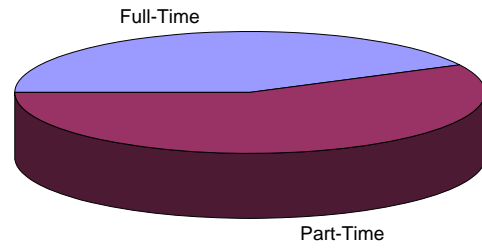


Table 5. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

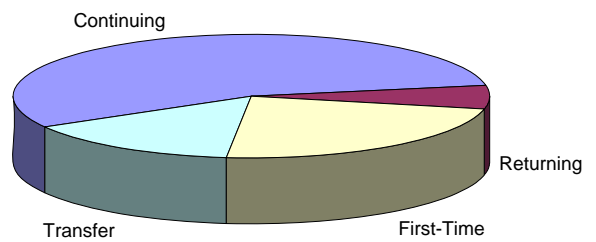


Table 6. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

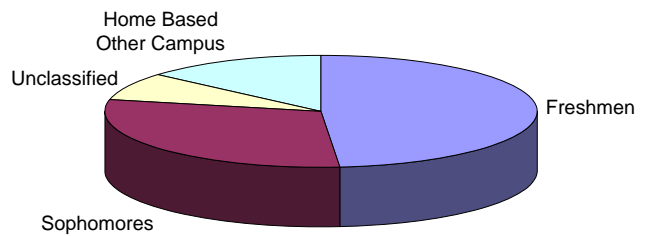

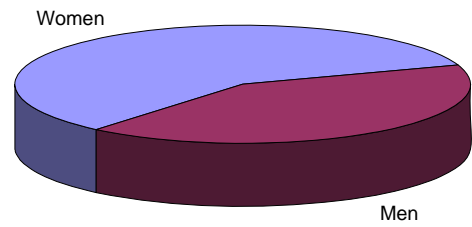


Table 8. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

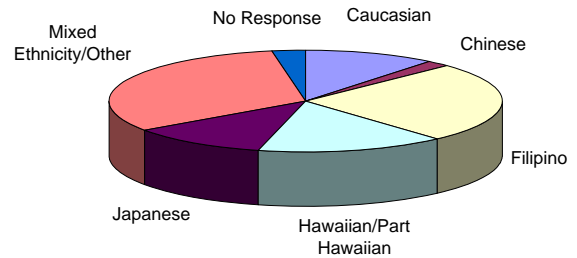

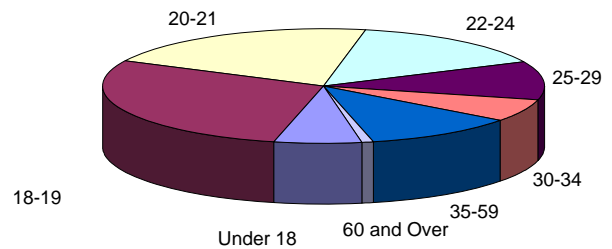


Table 10. Leeward Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

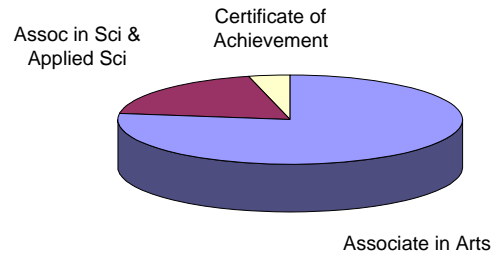


Table 11. Leeward Community College Last Attended Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

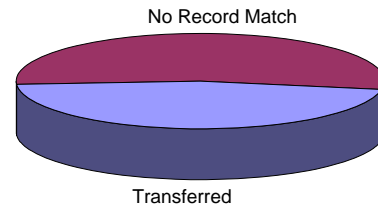


Table 12. Leeward Community College Transfers Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

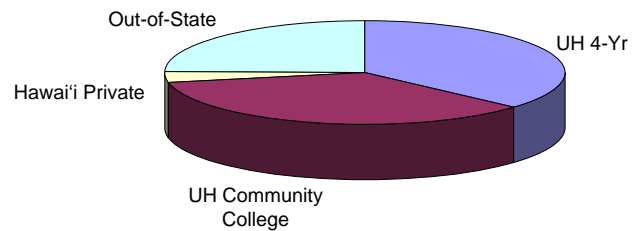

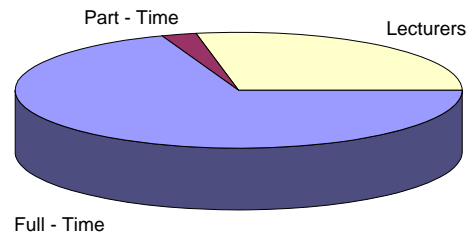


Table 14. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

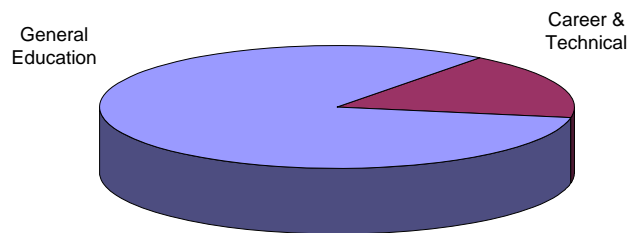


Table 15. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

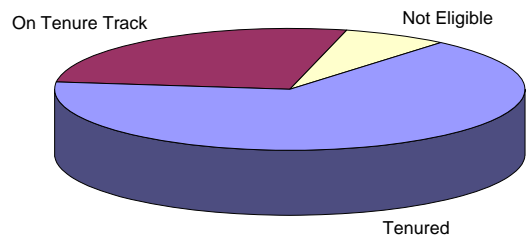

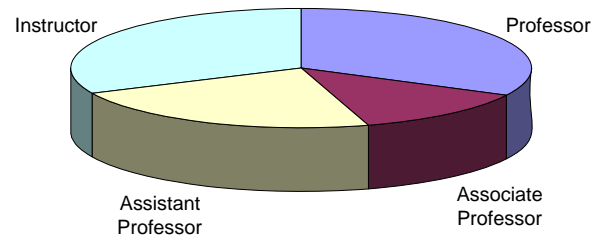


Table 17. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

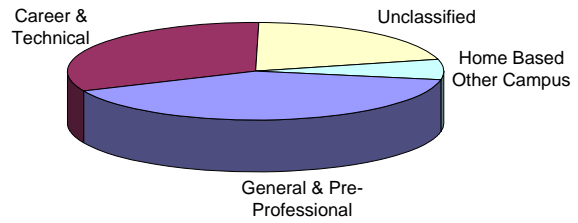

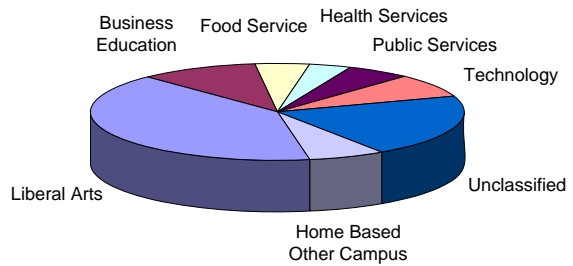

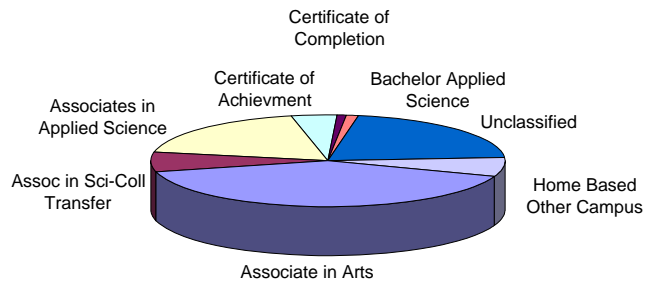


Table 4. Maui Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2006

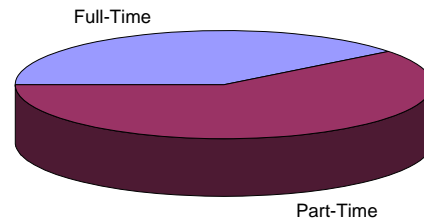


Table 5. Maui Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

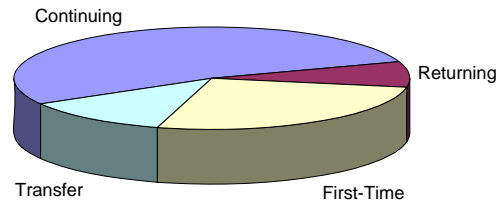


Table 6. Maui Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

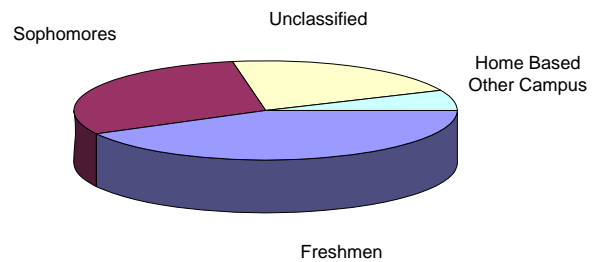


Table 7. Maui Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2006

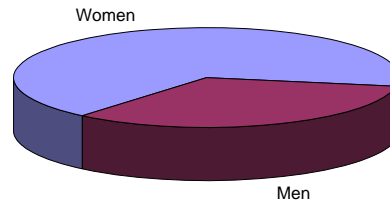


Table 8. Maui Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

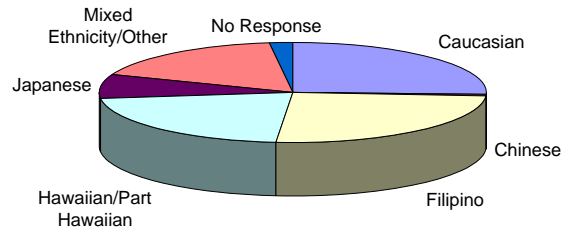


Table 9. Maui Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2006

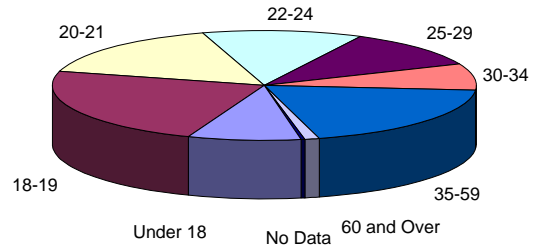


Table 10. Maui Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

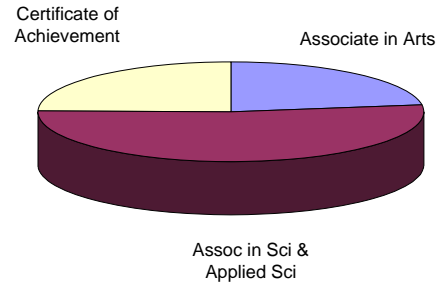


Table 11. Maui Community College Last Term Attended Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

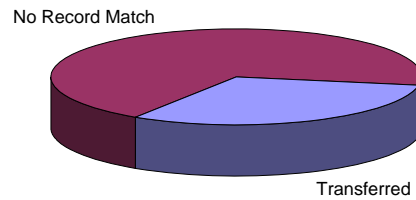


Table 12. Maui Community College Transfers Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

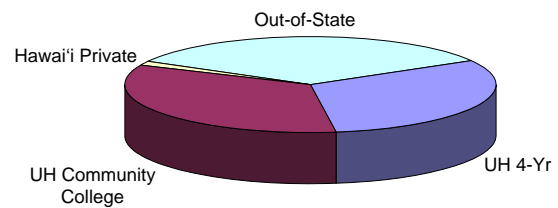


Table 13. Maui Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2006

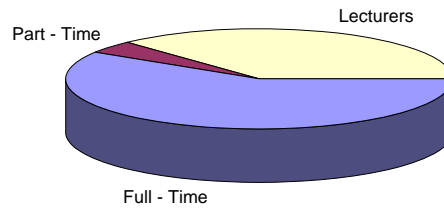


Table 14. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

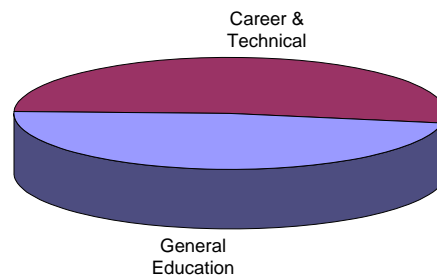


Table 15. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

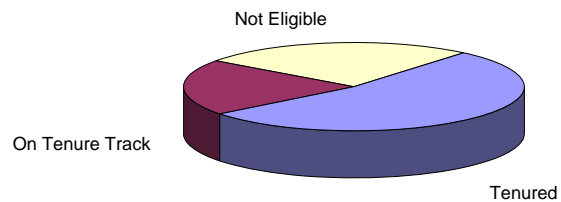


Table 16. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2006

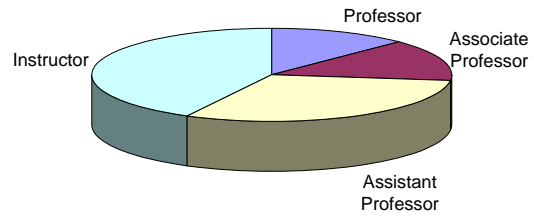


Table 17. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

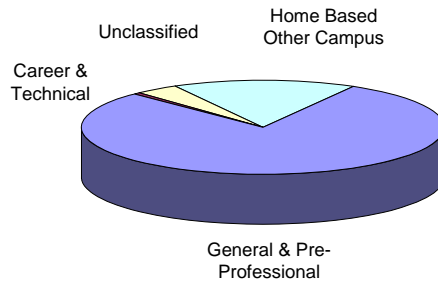

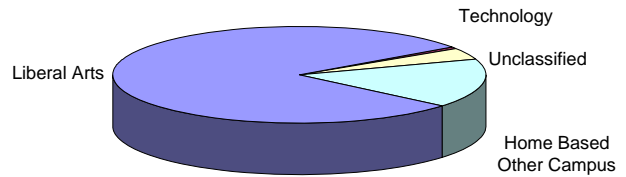

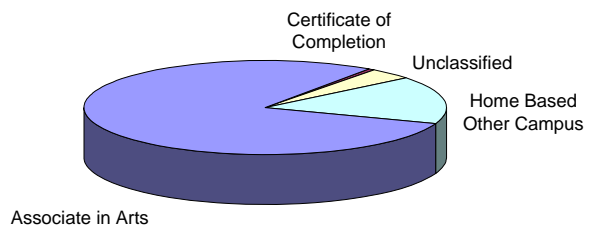


Table 4. Windward Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2006

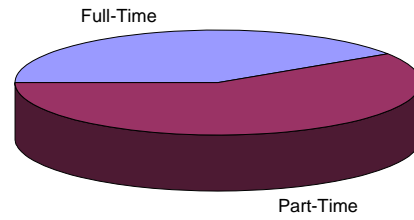


Table 5. Windward Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2006

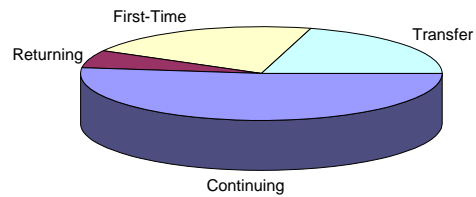


Table 6. Windward Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2006

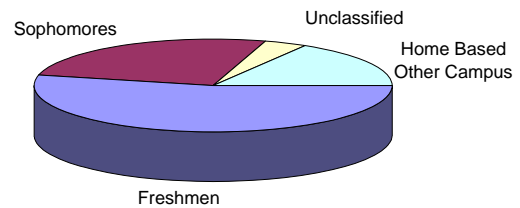


Table 7. Windward Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2006

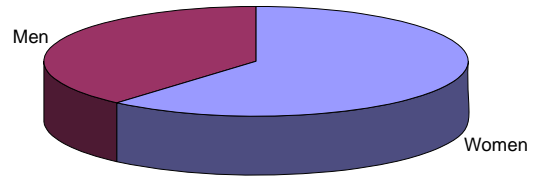


Table 8. Windward Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

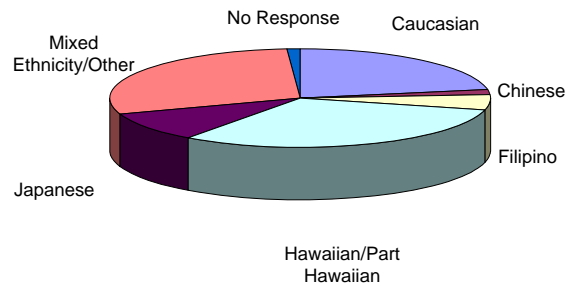

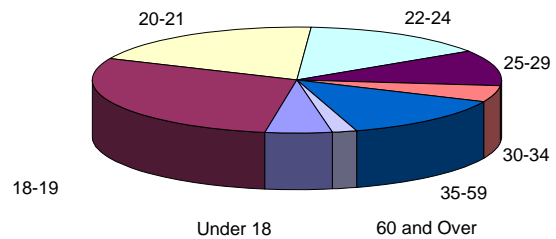


Table 10. Windward Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Fiscal Year 2005-06

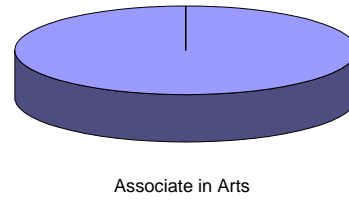


Table 11. Windward Community College Last Term Attended Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

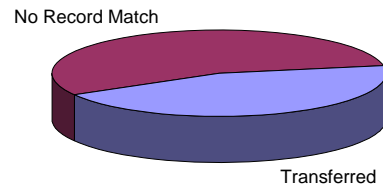


Table 12. Windward Community College Transfers Fall 2002 - Summer 2006

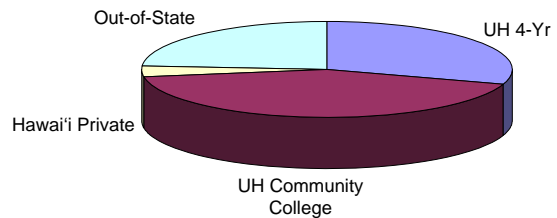


Table 13. Windward Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2006

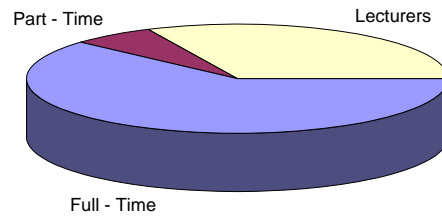


Table 14. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2006

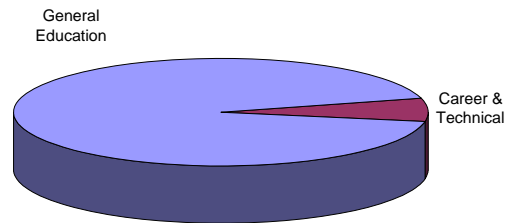


Table 15. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2006

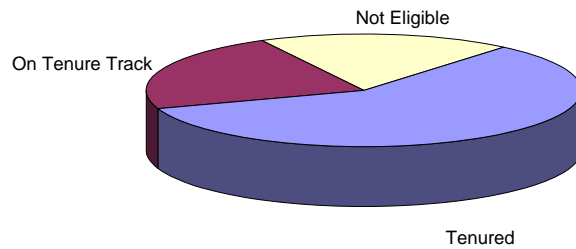


Table 16. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2006

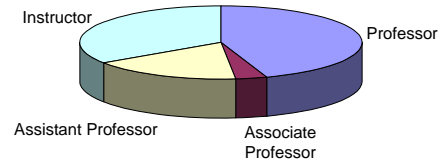


Table 17. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2006

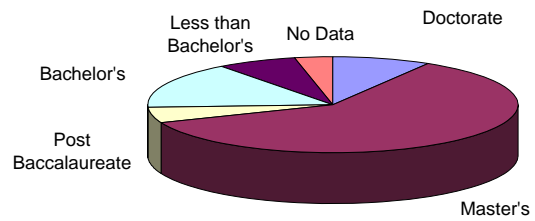


Table 18. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2006

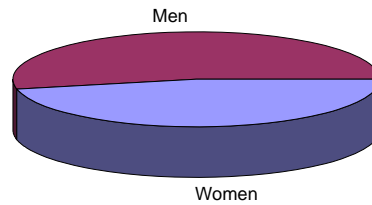
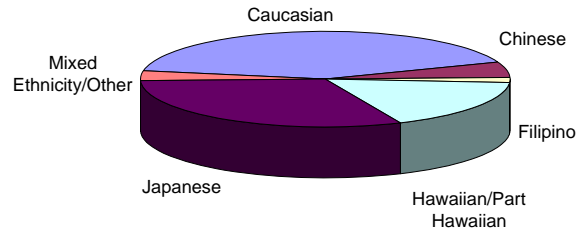


Table 19. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2006
