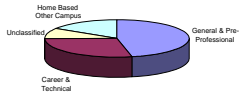

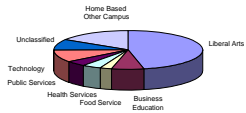


Table 3. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2008

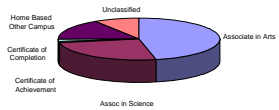


Table 4. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2008

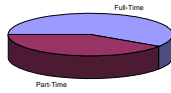


Table 5. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

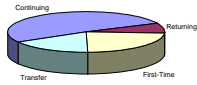


Table 6. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

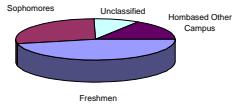


Table 7. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

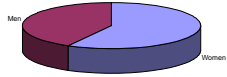


Table 8. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

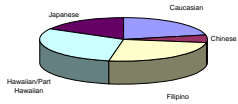


Table 9. UH Community Colleges Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

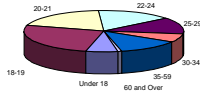


Table 10. UH Community Colleges Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2006-07

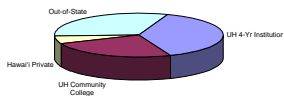


Table 13. UH Community Colleges Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2008

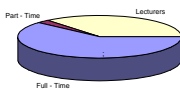


Table 14. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

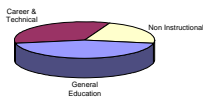


Table 15. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2008

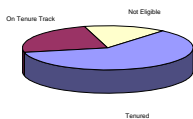


Table 16. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2008

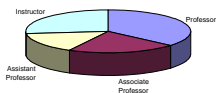


Table 17. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2008

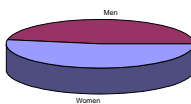
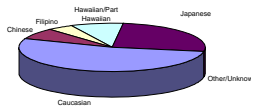


Table 19. UH Community Colleges Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

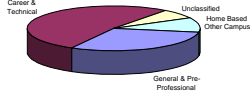


Table 2. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2008

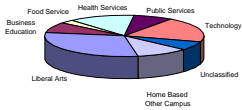


Table 3. Hawaii Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2008

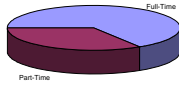


Table 5. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

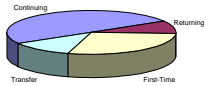


Table 6. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

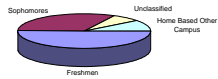


Table 7. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

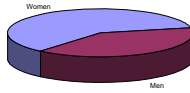


Table 8. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

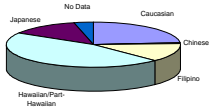


Table 9. Hawai'i Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

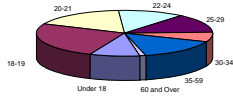


Table 10. Hawai'i Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2006-07

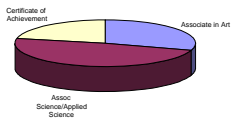


Table 11. Hawai'i Community College Last Term Attended Fall 2005 to Spring 2008

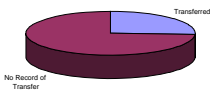


Table 12. Hawai'i Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2004 to Spring 2008)

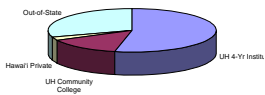


Table 13. Hawai'i Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2008

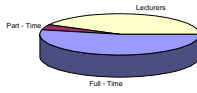


Table 14. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

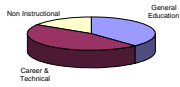


Table 15. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2008

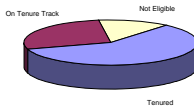


Table 16. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2008

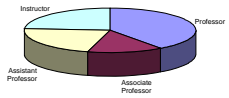


Table 17. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2008

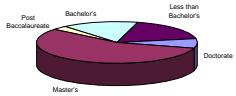


Table 18. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2008

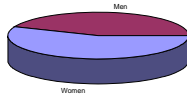
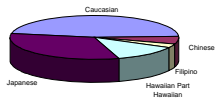


Table 19. Hawai'i Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

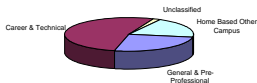


Table 2. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2008

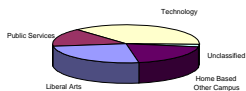


Table 3. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2008

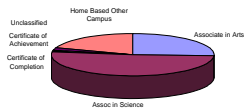


Table 4. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2008

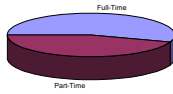


Table 5. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

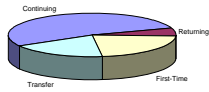


Table 6. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

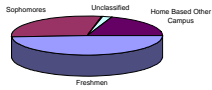


Table 7. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

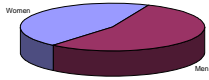


Table 8. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

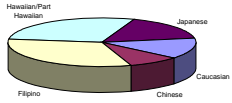


Table 9. Honolulu Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

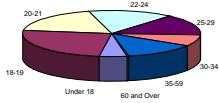


Table 10. Honolulu Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2006-07

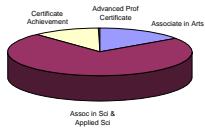


Table 11. Honolulu Community College Last Term Attended Fall 2005 to Spring 2008

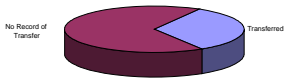


Table 12. Honolulu Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2005 to Spring 2008)

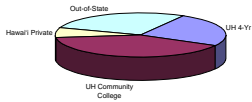


Table 13. Honolulu Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2008

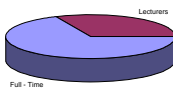


Table 14. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

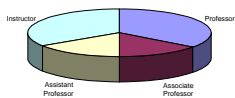


Table 17. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2008

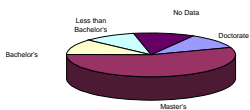


Table 18. Honolulu Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2008

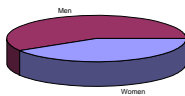
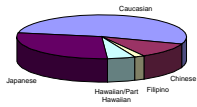

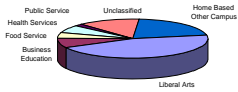


Table 3. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2008

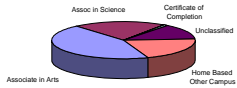


Table 4. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2008

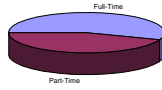


Table 5. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

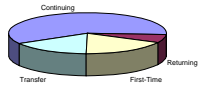


Table 6. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

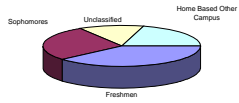


Table 7. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

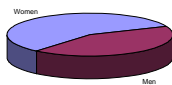


Table 8. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

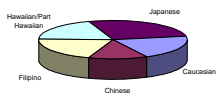


Table 9. Kapi'olani Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

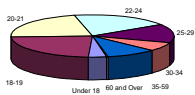


Table 10. Kapiolani Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2006-07

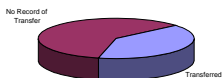


Table 12. Kapiolani Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2005 to Spring 2008)

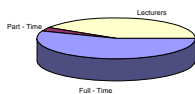


Table 14. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

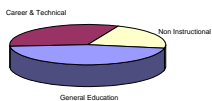


Table 15. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2008

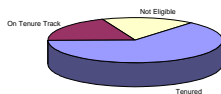


Table 16. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2008

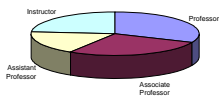


Table 17. Kapi'olani Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2008

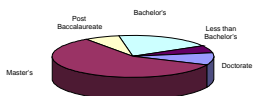


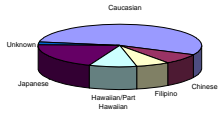

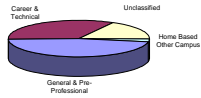


Table 2. Kauai Community College Enrollment by Program Area, Fall 2008

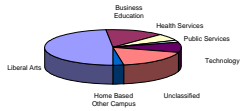


Table 3. Kauai Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2008

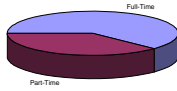


Table 5. Kauai Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

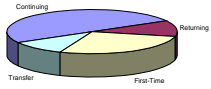


Table 6. Kauai Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

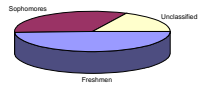


Table 7. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

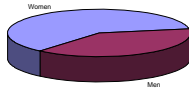


Table 8. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

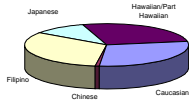


Table 9. Kaua'i Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

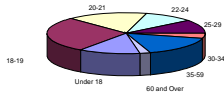


Table 10. Kauai Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2007-07

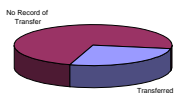


Table 12. Kauai Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2005 to Spring 2008)

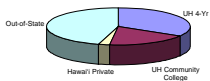


Table 13. Kauai Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2008

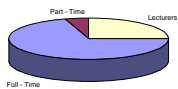


Table 14. Kauai Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

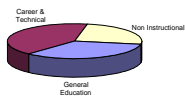


Table 15. Kauai Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2008

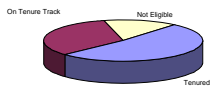


Table 16. Kauai Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2008

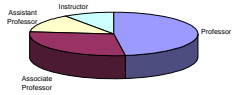


Table 17. Kauai Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2008

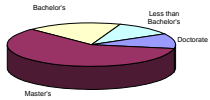


Table 18. Kauai Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2008

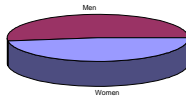
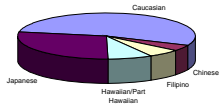

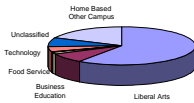


Table 3. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2008

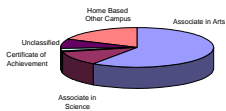


Table 4. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2008

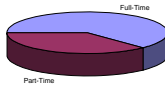


Table 5. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

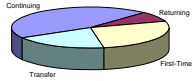


Table 6. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

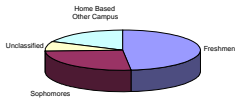


Table 7. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

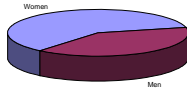


Table 8. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

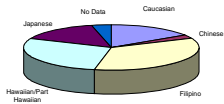


Table 9. Leeward Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

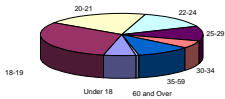


Table 10. Leeward Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2006-07

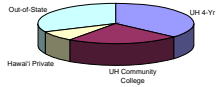


Table 13. Leeward Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2008

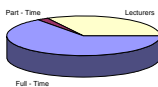


Table 14. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

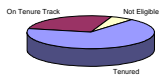


Table 16. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2008

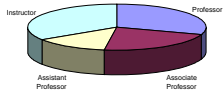


Table 17. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2008

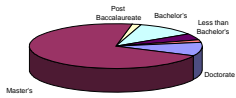


Table 18. Leeward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender, Fall 2008

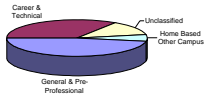

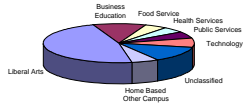

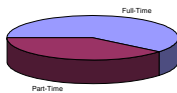


Table 5. Maui Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

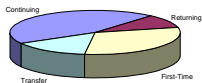


Table 6. Maui Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

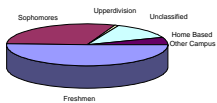


Table 7. Maui Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

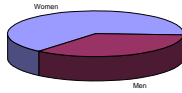


Table 8. Maui Community College Enrollment by Ethnicity, Fall 2008

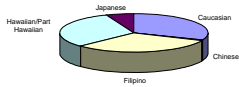


Table 9. Maui Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

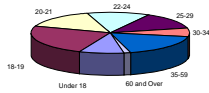


Table 10. Maui Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2006-07

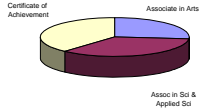


Table 11. Maui Community College Last Term Attended Fall 2005 - Spring 2008

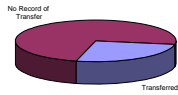


Table 12. Maui Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2005 to Spring 2008)

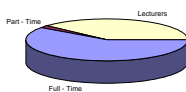


Table 14. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

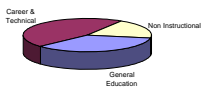


Table 15. Maui Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2008

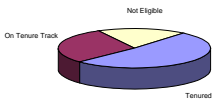


Table 16. Maul Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2008

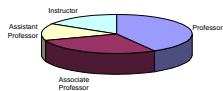


Table 17. Maul Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree, Fall 2008

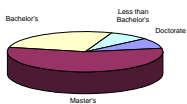


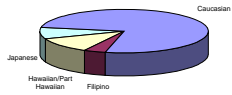

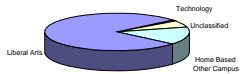


Table 3. Windward Community College Enrollment by Degree Objective, Fall 2008

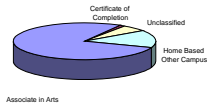


Table 4. Windward Community College Enrollment by Attendance Status, Fall 2008

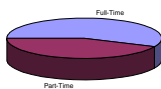


Table 5. Windward Community College Enrollment by Registration Status, Fall 2008

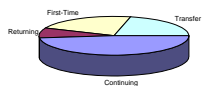


Table 6. Windward Community College Enrollment by Education Level, Fall 2008

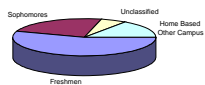


Table 7. Windward Community College Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2008

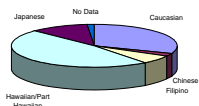


Table 9. Windward Community College Enrollment by Age, Fall 2008

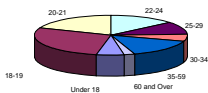


Table 10. Windward Community College Degrees and Certificates Earned, Academic Year 2006-07

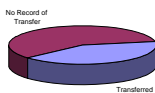


Table 12. Windward Community College Transfers Out (Last Enrolled Fall 2005 to Spring 2008)

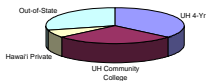


Table 13. Windward Community College Instructional Faculty by Employment Status, Fall 2008

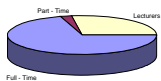


Table 14. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Instructional Area, Fall 2008

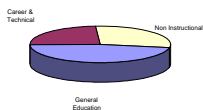


Table 15. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Tenure Status, Fall 2008

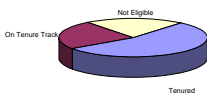


Table 16. Windward Community College Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank, Fall 2008

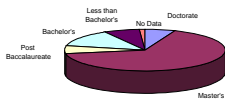


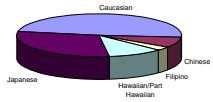
