Achieving the Dream Round Four Guidelines – selected sites will participate in a year-long planning process that leads to development of a four-year implementation work plan and budget. The implementation period will begin in July 2008 and extend through June 2012.

Each institution starts by forming teams to carry out the work of the initiative. A core team designs, oversees, and integrates the work. The core team develops and manages a process for institution-wide dialog about Achieving the Dream data findings, goals, and strategies. The team works with and through the institution councils, departments, and divisions to adopt priorities for improving student success, particularly for underserved populations.
