Achieving the Dream Round Four Guidelines – selected sites will participate in a year-long planning process that leads to development of a four-year implementation work plan and budget. The implementation period will begin in July 2008 and extend through June 2012.

Each institution starts by forming teams to carry out the work of the initiative. The primary role of the state policy team is to promote policy innovations (both administrative and legislative) that improve the climate and provide incentives that help community colleges adopt practices and policies to improve student outcomes and success.
