Continuing Business

- □ Program Review Cheryl Chappell-Long reported there was a revised draft of attachments 1-A, 1-B being reviewed by the Instructional Program Review Committee (I-PRC). The revision was designed to reduce the number of quantitative indicators and include required elements from Executive Policy (E5.202) and Perkins Law. The revised policy/attachments would be effective for Fall 2007 reports. Each college has representation on the committee. Concerns, issues, questions (such as timeline for receiving data and report) should be communicated through the college representative.
- □ Prerequisite Validation Pilot Study Work Group will meet Friday October 13, 2006 to review the draft report. The final report will be forwarded to the Vice President for Community Colleges (VPCC) for review. It is anticipated the VPCC will forward the report to College Chancellors for review and comment.
- ☐ The Institutional Research Calendar has been posted to the web.
- □ DOSS update Earl Nishiguchi reported that:
 - The revised elements for the program review attachment on Student Services has been submitted.
 - The Deans of Student Services (DOSS) are including more elements from CCSSE results in their program review.
 - DOSS approved questions (attached) to capture student educational goals via the student portal.
- □ DOI update -- Mike Pecsok not present.

New Items and Other Matters:

- □ Remedial/Developmental Programs White Paper Cheryl Chappell-Long reported that a system group (list of members attached), reporting to the Deans of Instruction, has been formed to study the issues and make recommendations for improvement to colleges' programs. The paper will also address curriculum alignment with secondary schools. The charge to the group and records of meetings will be posted to the UHCC website.
- ☐ Distance Education Helen Sina will reconvene UHCC systemwide Distance Learning/Distance Education Group. The group may be requesting data.
- □ APAPA update:
 - Perkins IV the law now addresses Career Technical Education vice Vocational
 Education. The cadre expressed interest in refresher training on data and procedures
 when the data are released to the colleges and that a Perkins area be established on
 the UHCC website to house refresher training materials. Cheryl Chappell-Long
 volunteered to conduct on-site training for college staff and faculty.
 - Measuring Our Progress preliminary reports may be available for the ACCJC visits.
 - CCSSE UHCC system has purchase additional CCSSE results reports that include CTE vs Liberal Arts students and CTE students analyses.
 - ACCJC Visits ACCJC teams will want to meet with IR CADRE members. OVPCC has posted accreditation resources on line. Cadre members are encouraged to contact APAPA for any additional assistance.
