1.1 Increase NH Enrollment by 3% per year Discussion:

- ➤ OK to keep data elements from Fall enrollment to >49 years old
- ➤ Should we <u>continue</u> to track the data elements for the AtD Cohort AtD Fall Cohort, Atd Cohort Full Time in Fall, & AtD Cohort Part time in Fall?
- Recommendation: replace AtD cohort data with data to include ALL NH
- ➤ Full time is 12+ credits

Part time is <12 credits

Recommendation: System break down the data by credits. Example:

1-6 credits

7-11 credits

12+ credits

- Recommendation: ADD NH Globally Competitive Workforce, reference 4.1 High wage, STEM Certificates and Degrees, 4 year Certificates & Degrees in STEM
- Data for NH students in underserved areas if possible. Geographical data
- 1.2 Increase Financial Aid Participation/Award Native Hawaiian
 - > Shall we or can we track external financial aid awards for NH?
- 1.3 Increase Developmental Education Success Native Hawaiian
 - ➤ Recommendation: Capture data for ALL NH students instead of for only AtD cohort.
- 1.4 Increase Persistence/Graduation/Transfer Native Hawaiian
 - > Track "PACE" to graduation
 - ➤ Rate of change/growth. See Graduation Initiative increase by 25% of population having a degree or certificate by 2025
