**SB 3110: RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PERTAINING TO
HIGHER EDUCATION**

Chair Sakamoto and Members of the Senate Committee on Education:

The University of Hawai'i strongly supports SB 3110. This bill proposes an appropriation of \$281.284 million from State general revenues for various capital improvements program (CIP) projects at University of Hawai'i campuses.

SB 3110 proposes full funding of all eleven projects included in the Board of Regents' CIP Budget for Supplemental Year 2004-2005, and adds seven additional projects not included in the Regents' CIP Budget.

Should full funding not be available for all projects included in SB 3110, we respectfully request that priority be given to projects that are included in the Board of Regents' CIP Budget.
