


VICE PRESIDENT FOR RESEARCH

This is executive leadership for the University of Hawai'i involving the planning, coordination, and development of system wide research policies and procedures as well as the management of research-related administrative support services. As chief research policy advisor to the President, work involves overall executive leadership of system wide policy development as it relates to research; serving as a liaison between the President and the Chancellor of University of Hawai'i, Manoa, and the Research Corporation of the University of Hawai'i, to maintain and promote effective administrative and operational relationships; developing and implementing long-range planning studies for research initiatives and programs; initiating qualitative evaluation of major efforts relative to the development and maintenance of an international standard of excellence; determining direction toward supporting new research and the enhancement of research beneficial to the University system; supporting research endeavors, initiatives and programs, and providing a system wide environment conducive to the further development of research; ensuring administrative staff support to enable and facilitate effective research development.

Work entails directing system wide policies through the development of governing policies; assisting in the development and integration of research institute operations and activities into University operations and programs; insuring that all administrative compliance and reporting requirements are fulfilled, communicating with parties within and outside the University actively involved in the University's research interest, including federal, state, and private agencies. Work requires extensive knowledge of higher education academic programs and related administrative structures and systems, as well as demonstrated experience in planning strategies and policy formulation processes. Work is reviewed by the President for results achieved.

In accordance with the Board of Regents' action taken on January 17, 2003, this class is established effective January 1, 2003.
