

**MAUI ADMINISTRATOR, TECHNOLOGY  
TRANSFER AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

DEFINITION

This administrative work in the planning, coordinating, and administering the technology transfer and economic development programs for the County of Maui. Work involves the responsibility for providing access to University resources and facilities for local businesses, entrepreneurs, government agencies, etc.; coordinating and administering University facilities in the Maui Research and Technology Center at Kihei; conducting studies to identify areas where university resources may be employed to assist or facilitate the transfer of new technology. Work requires extensive public contact with representatives in state, federal and county governments, private sector corporations, entrepreneurs, and other business organizations. Knowledge of technology marketing techniques, government programs on economic and business development in Hawaii; experience and knowledge in the requirements of private-public partnerships; ability to work well with the business community. Work is reviewed on the basis of results achieved.

The establishment of the class, Maui, Administrator, Technology Transfer and Economic Development is approved.
