Instructions for Preparing an Abstract (Spring ASM Meeting, April 25, 2009)

An abstract submission is REQUIRED for oral presentations. Abstracts should be informative and contain the following information:

- 1. Title
- 2. List of authors and department affiliations
- 3. Objectives
- 4. Methods (if pertinent)
- 5. Results
- 6. Conclusions
- 7. Impact and Significance

Instructions for Oral Presentations

Oral presentations are allotted 10 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for questions/discussion. Presentations should look professional and students are strongly encouraged to rehearse prior to the day of the meeting. Standard MS PowerPoint presentations are strongly recommended, and LCD projectors and computers will be available. Please bring your presentation 30 minutes prior to the start of the meeting for download. If you are using a Mac, please double check your presentation on a PC compatible computer for shifting of figures, letters or fonts.
